ABOUT THE AUTHOR

TIMOTHY II

In 1967, I was in the middle of my career as a “Head Football Coach” in a High School in Southern California.

After having an ‘Undefeated Championship Team’ during the regular season, and being selected “Orange County Coach of the Year”, my wife’s younger sister was killed in an automobile accident. She was survived by her husband and four children.

This sudden shock in the middle of my most exciting coaching year, led my wife and I to ask the Lord into our lives in a small church in Anaheim.

This in itself would be the conclusion of my testimony, if it were not for God’s sovereign intervention.

In 1985, after thirty years of coaching football and winning numerous awards in High School and College coaching, I had a heart attack.

Since 1967, I had been going to church regularly, attending Bible studies, tithing and reading the Bible daily.

The only problems I had, were alcohol and ego. It started out with the usual occasional use of alcohol but developed into daily use.

When I entered the hospital in 1985, I passed all the physical exams and tests I was given. The doctors concluded that I had a slight heart attack but it was over and I was fine.

As I was preparing to go home and my wife was coming to pick me up, I suddenly had a “ventricular fibrillation” attack in the hospital.

It was at this time that I had a real “Death Experience” as well as an “Out of Body Experience”.

As I fell on the hospital bed, I left my body and went immediately out of this world, and into “Outer Darkness”. I went floating on my back into a black void with no sound, in complete blackness, and I knew I was totally separated from God for eternity.

(Job 10:21-22 Jude 13)

With “weeping and gnashing of teeth”, I cried out to the Lord and said, “I haven’t done anything for you Lord, please give me another chance”. I also said, “My wife and family wasn’t expecting me to die, what will happen to them?” (Matt. 8:12, 22:13, 25:30)

I continued to float in “Outer Darkness”, weeping and crying out to the Lord.

Just as suddenly as I began floating into “Outer Darkness”, I floated back into the hospital room and into my body. I rose up in my body like it was filling up from the bottom to the top and my eyes opened up in front of many doctors and nurses.

After resting about four hours from this experience, I was lying in my bed and I opened up my Bible to Second Timothy. It was at this time that the Lord spoke to me audibly. He said, "My son Timothy, if you don't do My Will, I will remove you from this earth". (Jeremiah 28:15-16)
I said, "I will Lord".

He then said He named me "Timothy", so that all the work that I do for Him, would be done in this name. This way, my ego would not get in the way and I would know it was Him doing the work and not me.

He told me my work is in 2 Timothy 2:2 "And the things that thou has heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also".

Although, this was Paul talking to Timothy, the Lord said this would be Him talking to me. Thus I have taken the name "Timothy II".

Some of the things the Lord told Timothy II, was to tell the Body of Christ that "He is coming soon, very soon, sooner than you think". He told me that the "Body of Christ", in addition to saving souls, must Repent from dead works, backslidden conditions, and to restore the divided body from envy, strife, etc.; and to also restore Christian marriages.

After this experience was over, the Lord told me to have my sister, who is in the ministry, to come and lay hands on me to receive the "Filling of the Spirit", to give me the 'power' to do His work. This she did.

Later on, the doctors found out through an angiogram, that my left coronary artery was ninety-five percent blocked and I had to have an "angioplasty" to clear it. The Lord healed me through this method and I have been fine since.

The Lord completely delivered me from alcohol and also took away the desire for it.

Since 1985, the Lord has Called and trained myself and my wife Lavona, along with "The Team" which He has raised, to minister with Apostles, and to Prophets, Pastors, Priests, Evangelists and Church Leaders. He has used us to love, encourage, build up, edify, and to rebuke when necessary, these men and women of God.

God is judging His Church today, for judgment "must begin" at the "House of God". (1 Peter 4:17)

This is being done in the "Spirit of Elijah". (Isaiah 40:3; Luke 1:17; Luke 3:4)
The judgment is based on Revelation 2 & 3.

He that hath ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the Churches.
(Revelation 2:7, 2:11, 2:17, 2:29, 3:6, 3:13, 3:22)

FOREWORD

On March 19, 1988, Timothy II went on a retreat with about eighty men from the “Church of the Coastland” in Huntington Beach, California. They went to a barren desert place south of Palm Springs.

After fasting for about two days, each of them went to a far off place by themselves, to be alone and to seek the “Will of God” in their lives.

It was here that the Lord spoke to Timothy II for almost two hours, as He outlined “His Plan” for “His Work”; and Timothy II wrote it down in a notebook.

Along with other messages, the Lord outlined His “Ten Commandments for the Church”.

Then He said, “You will be sent out.....”

When the Lord finished speaking to Timothy II, He said to close the book in which he was writing, and not to open it or share the contents with anyone, until he shared it at home with his wife Lavona. This he did.

Although Timothy II wasn’t sure at the time what the Lord meant about “The Ten Commandments for the Church”, He later confirmed His message by the Scriptures in the Bible.

The Lord is now sending Timothy II and “The Team”, as well as others, who are “Called”, to go to the churches in the United States and around the world, to help prepare the “Body of Christ” for “His Soon Coming”.

This preparation will be done through the work of the “Ten Commandments for the Church”. (Revelation 19:7)

The following are these “Ten Commandments”.

The Scriptures that confirm them, are those which God the Holy Spirit has impressed on Timothy II over the last several years.

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the Churches.

I. YOU WILL RESTORE MY CHURCH:

God is sending out His Called “Apostles/Messengers” in these last days to “Restore” His “True Church” (John 4:23-24 15:26 Eph. 2:19-22); which is the “Body of Christ”. (Eph. 4:16)

The “Restoration of His Church” will not be done through seminars, conferences, conventions, etc. This won’t work; if it could, it would have already happened.

This is because these are man’s attempts to bring the “Church” together.

Only the Lord can “Restore His Church”, and He will use His own methods, means, and ‘chosen ones’ to do His work. These ‘unknown’ Servants of His will have no agenda to follow, but will only be led by God the Holy Spirit.

The following Scriptures confirm the orders to ‘Go’ and do this work!

Jer 1:7-10

7 But **the LORD said unto me**, Say not, I am a child: for **thou shalt go to all that I shall send thee, and whatsoever I command thee thou shalt speak.**

8 Be not afraid of their faces: for **I am with thee** to deliver thee, **saith the LORD.**

9 Then the LORD put forth his hand, and touched my mouth. **And the LORD said unto me, Behold, I have put my words in thy mouth.**

10 See, **I have this day set thee over the nations (Denominations) and over the kingdoms (Churches), to root out, and to pull down, and to destroy, and to throw down, to build, and to plant.**

Jer 18:7-10

7 **At what instant I shall speak concerning a nation, and concerning a kingdom, to pluck up, and to pull down, and to destroy it;**

8 **If that nation, against whom I have pronounced, turn from their evil, I will repent of the evil that I thought to do unto them.**

9 **And at what instant I shall speak concerning a nation, and concerning a kingdom, to build and to plant it;**

10 **If it do evil in my sight, that it obey not my voice, then I will repent of the good, wherewith I said I would benefit them.**

Jer 51:20-23

20 **Thou art my battle axe and weapons of war: for with thee will I break in pieces the nations (Denominations), and with thee will I destroy kingdoms (Churches);**

21 **And with thee will I break in pieces the horse (the Flesh) and his rider (those in the flesh); and with thee will I break in pieces the chariot (Idolatry) and his rider (those in idolatry);**

22 **With thee also will I break in pieces man and woman; and with thee will I break in pieces the young man and the maid;**

23 **I will also break in pieces with thee the shepherd (Pastor / Priest) and his flock; and with thee will I break in pieces the husbandman (the Evangelist) and his yoke of oxen (Team); and with thee will I break in pieces captains and rulers (Leaders).**

Read: (Isaiah 10:33-34 31:1, 3 Haggai 2:22)
(1 Samuel 15:23 1 Corinthians 5:11 Ephesians 5:5-7)

Jer 7:2-3

2 **Stand in the gate of the LORD's house, and proclaim there this word, and say, Hear the word of the LORD, all ye of Judah, that enter in at these gates to worship the LORD.**

3 **Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Amend your ways and your doings, and I will cause you to dwell in this place.**

Jer 26:2

2 **Thus saith the LORD; Stand in the court of the LORD's house, and speak unto all the cities (People) of Judah, which come to worship in the LORD's house, all the words that I command thee to speak unto them; diminish not a word:**

These Called Apostles/Messengers of God will have a Team and/or Company just as Paul had his Company. (Acts 13:13 21:8)

Isa 58:12

12 **And they that shall be of thee (The Team) shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations (that has been destroyed); and thou shalt be called, The repairer of the breach, The restorer of paths to dwell in.**

Isa 61:4

4 **And they shall build the old wastes, they shall raise up the former desolations, and they shall repair the waste cities, the desolations of many generations.**

Matt 17:11

11 **And Jesus answered and said unto them, Elias (Elijah) truly shall first come, and restore all things.**

The Messenger will go forth in the 'Spirit of Elijah' (the Holy Spirit). (Mark 9:12)

Mal 4:5-6

5 **Behold, I will send you (the Spirit of) Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:**

6 **And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.**

Luke 1:17

17 And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias (Elijah), to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient (Children) to the wisdom of the just (Fathers); to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.

The 'Spirit of Elijah' (the Holy Spirit) will bring a restoration of Christian marriages and families through Repentance.

This must be done first, before God's Church (the Body of Christ) can be restored.

1 Tim 3:2

2 A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach;

1 Tim 3:4-5

4 One that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity;

5 (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?)

1 Tim 3:12

12 Let the deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling their children and their own houses well.

II. YOU WILL PRONOUNCE SOUND DOCTRINE:

Today, there are so many “Winds of Doctrine” going around in the churches, that it is hard to understand what is the ‘Truth’.

Jesus said, I will send you the Comforter (the Holy Ghost) which is the ‘Spirit of Truth’, He will guide you into ‘All Truth’. (John 14:16-17, 26 16:13).

We need to listen to God the Holy Spirit!

Some of the “Winds of Doctrine” are ‘False Doctrine’ and some of it is ‘Unsound Doctrine’. (Read the Books on “Unsound Doctrine” & “What is Truth?” by Timothy II). ‘False Doctrine’ is easier to recognize than ‘Unsound Doctrine’; however, they are both bad because they will take you away from your first love (Jesus). (Rev. 2:4)

The following Scriptures reveal the ‘Truth’ about “Sound Doctrine”.

1 Tim 1:2-7

2 **Unto Timothy**, my own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord.

3 As I besought thee to abide still at Ephesus, when I went into Macedonia, that thou mightest **charge some that they teach no other doctrine,**

4 **Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies**, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: so do.

5 **Now the end of the commandment is charity (Love) out of a pure heart**, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned:

6 **From which some having swerved have turned aside unto vain jangling;**

7 Desiring to be teachers of the law; **understanding neither what they say, nor whereof they affirm.**

1 Tim 1:9-10

9 Knowing this, that **the law is not made for a righteous man**, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers,

10 For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, **and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine;**

1 Tim 4:6

6 **If thou put the brethren in remembrance of these things, thou shalt be a good minister of Jesus Christ**, nourished up in the words of faith **and of good doctrine**, whereunto thou hast attained.

2 Tim 4:2-4

2 **Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.**

3 **For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine;** but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;

4 **And they shall turn away their ears from the truth,** and shall be turned unto fables.

Titus 1:7

7 **For a bishop** (Episkopos - Overseer) **must be blameless,** as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre;

Titus 1:9

9 **Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers.**

Titus 2:1-15

1 **But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:**

2 That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.

3 The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;

4 That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children,

5 To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

6 Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded.

7 In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: **in doctrine shewing uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity,**

8 **Sound speech, that cannot be condemned;** that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.

9 Exhort servants to be obedient unto their own masters, and to please them well in all things; not answering again;

10 Not purloining, but shewing all good fidelity; **that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Saviour in all things.**

11 **For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,**

12 **Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;**

13 **Looking for that blessed hope,** and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

14 **Who gave himself for us,** that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

15 **These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority.** Let no man despise thee.

III. YOU WILL BRING IT (THE CHURCH) TOGETHER:

The Lord will actually bring the Church together, but He will do it through His Called “Apostles/Messengers”. The Lord will first break the ‘Denominational’ and ‘Church’ barriers that have been present for so many years. This has been the main cause of the “Church” not coming together as the “Body of Christ”.

The Lord will do this by taking these ‘Dead Churches’ that have become a ‘Wilderness’, and put it in their hearts to ‘Go Out’.

This will start with the Pastors / Priests, by God giving them an ‘Evangelistic Heart’. (Numbers 27:16-17) Which He is doing now!

The results will be that the Pastors / Priests and their flocks will ‘Go Out’ of their buildings and bring in people of different racial, ethnic, cultural and economic backgrounds. (Luke 14:21-24)

For this is the Will of God! Amen!

Isa 41:18-20

18 I will open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys: **I will make the wilderness (The Church) a pool of water**, and the dry land springs of water.

19 **I will plant in the wilderness (The Church) the cedar, the shittah tree, and the myrtle, and the oil tree; I will set in the desert the fir tree, and the pine, and the box tree together:** (All colors and types of people)

20 **That they may see, and know, and consider, and understand together, that the hand of the LORD hath done this, and the Holy One of Israel hath created it.**

(The Church in Philadelphia):

Isa 60:11-13

11 **Therefore thy gates shall be open continually they shall not be shut day nor night;** that men may bring unto thee the forces of the Gentiles, and that their kings may be brought.

12 **For the nation (Denomination) and kingdom (Church) that will not serve thee shall perish; yea, those nations (Denominations) shall be utterly wasted.**

13 **The glory of Lebanon shall come unto thee, the fir tree, the pine tree, and the box together (The different types of people), to beautify the place of my sanctuary; and I will make the place of my feet glorious.**

The Messenger is to go through the gates of the churches and cast up the Highway:

Isa 62:10

10 **Go through, go through the gates; prepare ye the way of the people; cast up, cast up the highway (The Highway to Heaven); gather out the stones; lift up a standard for the people.**

What is the Highway and the Way?

Prov 16:17

17 **The highway of the upright is to depart from evil:** he that keepeth his way preserveth his soul.

Isa 35:8

8 **And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness;** the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err therein.

Read: (Proverbs 16:6)

The results of the Messenger going to the churches will be that we will:

Heb 12:14

14 **Follow peace with all men, and holiness,** without which no man shall see the Lord:

2 Cor 7:1

1 **Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.**

IV. YOU WILL CLEANSE IT WITHOUT SPOT OR WRINKLE:

Although the Lord is going to “Cleanse His Church” without “Spot or Wrinkle”; it is up to us to do the Work! The “Bride” must make herself ready! (Rev. 19:7)
This means that the Pastors / Priests need to cleanse their churches, before God sends His “Apostles/Messengers” to do it!

Eph 5:26-27

26 **That he might sanctify and cleanse it** with the washing of water **by the word** (Rhema or Spoken Word),

27 **That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.**

The spoken Word of God by the Messenger, is that the Word of God is the Sword of the Spirit.

Eph 6:17

17 **And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:**

And the Word of God for Pastors / Priests is that they must begin to address the issue of Sin in the Church!

I Jn 1:9-10

9 **If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.**

10 **If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.**

If Pastors / Priests do not address the issue of Sin in their churches, then the Cleansing of the Church, will be done by removing these ‘False Teachers’, who are always ‘walking after the flesh’. (1 John 4:5)

These ‘phony church leaders’ have a ‘form of Godliness’, but do not have God the Holy Spirit, and even deny the power thereof! (2 Tim. 3:5)

They may even begin denying our Lord Jesus Christ!

Deut 32:1-5

1 **Give ear, O ye heavens, and I will speak; and hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.**

2 **My doctrine shall drop as the rain, my speech shall distil as the dew, as the small rain upon the tender herb, and as the showers upon the grass:**

3 **Because I will publish the name of the LORD: ascribe ye greatness unto our God.**

4 He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.

5 **They have corrupted themselves, their spot is not the spot of his children:** they are a perverse and crooked generation.

2 Pet 2:1-2

1 But there were false prophets also among the people, even as **there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them,** and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

2 And **many shall follow their pernicious ways;** by reason of whom **the way of truth shall be evil spoken of.**

2 Pet 2:10

10 But **chiefly them that walk after the flesh** in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous are they, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities.

2 Pet 2:13-15

13 And shall receive the reward of unrighteousness, as **they that count it pleasure to riot in the day time. Spots they are and blemishes,** sporting themselves with their own deceivings while they feast with you;

14 Having eyes full of adultery, and **that cannot cease from sin;** beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children:

15 **Which have forsaken the right way,** and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; (Rev. 2:14)

2 Pet 2:18-19

18 For when they speak great swelling words of vanity, **they allure through the lusts of the flesh,** through much wantonness, **those that were clean escaped from them who live in error.**

19 **While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption:** for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage.

Jude 4

4 **For there are certain men crept in unawares,** who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, **ungodly men,** turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and **denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.**

Jude 11-12

11 Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, **and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward,** and perished in the gainsaying of Core. (Rev. 2:14)

12 **These are spots in your feasts of charity** (Love), when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots;

Jude 16

16 These are murmurers, complainers, **walking after their own lusts**; and their mouth speaketh great swelling words, having men's persons in admiration because of advantage.

Jude 19

19 **These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.**

The 'Good News' is that even some of these will be Saved! Although it will probably be done through FEAR!

Jude 22-23

22 **And of some have compassion, making a difference:**

23 **And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.**

Therefore Brethren:

2 Pet 3:14

14 **Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.**

1 Pet 1:18-19

18 **Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold,** from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers;

19 **But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:**

V. YOU WILL EXPOSE:

EVERY FALSE WAY:

The “Fear of the Lord” is to hate Evil. (Proverbs 8:13)

Through God’s Commandments and precepts, we get understanding, and that understanding is to hate “Every False Way”.

Ps 119:104

104 Through thy precepts I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way.

Because we hate “Every False Way, the Messenger must “Expose”:

False Prophets - False Teachers - False Witnesses - False Brethren.

FALSE APOSTLES: (not our responsibility)

Exposing “False Apostles” is the only exception to exposing “Every False Way”.

Those ‘Called’ to Judge the Church, will ‘not’ expose “False Apostles”; the Lord will do it!

He may do it through the Pastors / Priests themselves, such as in the Church at Ephesus!

Rev 2:2

2 I know thy works, and thy labour, and thy patience, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them liars:

Notice, it says they “Called” themselves “Apostles”, and are not!

These “False Apostles” are sent from Satan. That is why it is important to have the ‘Charisma Gift’ of ‘Discernment of spirits’ in order to test the spirits. (1 John 4:1)

2 Cor 11:4

4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit (Must Discern), which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.

2 Cor 11:13-15

13 For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ.

14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

TRUE APOSTLES:

The only reason why “True Apostles” are inserted here, is to show that there are “True Apostles/Messengers” today, and not all who ‘Call’ themselves “Apostles” are False! For more about “Apostles/Messengers”: (Read the Book “Apostle” by Timothy II).

1 Cor 9:1-2

1 **Am I not an apostle? am I not free? have I not seen Jesus Christ our Lord? are not ye my work in the Lord?**

2 If I be not an apostle unto others, yet doubtless I am to you: **for the seal of mine apostleship are ye in the Lord.**

2 Cor 12:12

12 Truly **the signs of an apostle** were wrought among you **in all patience, in signs, and wonders, and mighty deeds.**

Jesus gave the “Doma” Gift of “Apostleship” along with the other four “Doma” Gifts to the Church (the Body of Christ). It also states in the Scriptures that the “Doma” Gifts are for men, not just the 12 Disciples! Nowhere in the Scriptures does it say that this was for a certain period of time, or that just part of the Gifts are for now.

Eph 4:8

8 Wherefore he saith, When he (**Jesus**) ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and **gave (Doma) gifts unto men.**

Eph 4:11

11 **And he gave some, apostles;** and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; (The five Doma gifts)

Gal 1:1-2

1 **Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;)**

2 **And all the brethren which are with me** (the Company), unto the churches of Galatia:

FALSE PROPHETS:

There are “False Prophets” today, that must be removed in order to bring the “Body of Christ” together and to “Restore the Church”.

Remember, these “False Prophets” are ‘not’ sent from the Lord!

Jer 14:14-16

14 Then the LORD said unto me, **The prophets prophesy lies in my name: I sent them not, neither have I commanded them, neither spake unto them: they prophesy**

unto you **a false vision and divination**, and a thing of nought, **and the deceit of their heart.**

15 Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning the prophets that prophesy in my name, and I sent them not, yet they say, Sword and famine shall not be in this land; **By sword and famine shall those prophets be consumed.**

16 **And the people to whom they prophesy shall be cast out in the streets of Jerusalem because of the famine and the sword;** and they shall have none to bury them, them, their wives, nor their sons, nor their daughters: for I will pour their wickedness upon them.

Jer 23:11

11 **For both prophet and priest are profane;** yea, **in my house** have I found their wickedness, saith the LORD.

Jer 23:14

14 **I have seen also in the prophets of Jerusalem an horrible thing:** they commit adultery, and walk in lies: **they strengthen also the hands of evildoers, that none doth return from his wickedness** (Many through Psychology - Isaiah 30:1 Proverbs 28:13): they are all of them unto me as Sodom, and the inhabitants thereof as Gomorrah.

Jer 23:16-17

16 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, **Hearken not unto the words of the prophets that prophesy unto you:** they make you vain: **they speak a vision of their own heart, and not out of the mouth of the LORD.**

17 They say still unto them that despise me, The LORD hath said, Ye shall have peace; **and they say unto every one that walketh after the imagination of his own heart, No evil shall come upon you.**

Jer 23:20-22

20 The anger of the LORD shall not return, until he have executed, and till he have performed the thoughts of his heart: **in the latter days ye shall consider it perfectly.**

21 **I have not sent these prophets,** yet they ran: **I have not spoken to them, yet they prophesied.**

How to recognize a "False Prophet".

22 **But if they had stood in my counsel, and had caused my people to hear my words, then they should have turned them from their evil way, and from the evil of their doings.**

Jer 23:25-34

25 **I have heard what the prophets said, that prophesy lies in my name,** saying, I have dreamed, I have dreamed.

26 How long shall this be in the heart of the prophets that prophesy lies? yea, **they are prophets of the deceit of their own heart;**

27 Which think to cause my people to forget my name by their dreams which they tell every man to his neighbour, as their fathers have forgotten my name for Baal.

28 **The prophet that hath a dream, let him tell a dream; and he that hath my word, let him speak my word faithfully.** What is the chaff to the wheat? saith the LORD.

29 **Is not my word like as a fire?** saith the LORD; **and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?**

God is against the “False Prophets” that lie, prophesy false dreams, and take things lightly. Also those that steal God’s Word from others and not from God’s prophecy to them!

30 Therefore, behold, **I am against the prophets,** saith the LORD, **that steal my words every one from his neighbour.**

31 Behold, **I am against the prophets,** saith the LORD, **that use their tongues, and say, He saith.**

32 Behold, **I am against them that prophesy false dreams,** saith the LORD, and do tell them, **and cause my people to err by their lies, and by their lightness;** yet I sent them not, nor commanded them: therefore they shall not profit this people at all, saith the LORD.

If they talk about the Burden of the Lord, remember there is no Burden from the Lord!

33 **And when this people, or the prophet, or a priest, shall ask thee,** saying, **What is the burden of the LORD?** thou shalt then say unto them, **What burden? I will even forsake you, saith the LORD.** (A Warning)

Do not even answer them. (Matthew 7:6)

34 **And as for the prophet, and the priest, and the people, that shall say, The burden of the LORD, I will even punish that man and his house.**

Some of these “False Prophets” are drinkers of alcohol!

Isa 28:7-8

7 But they also have erred through wine, and through strong drink are out of the way; **the priest and the prophet have erred through strong drink,** they are swallowed up of wine, they are out of the way through strong drink; **they err in vision, they stumble in judgment.**

8 For all tables are full of vomit and filthiness, so that there is no place clean.

The Messenger is to Prophecy against the “False Prophets”.

Ezek 13:2-9

2 **Son of man, prophesy against the prophets of Israel that prophesy, and say thou unto them that prophesy out of their own hearts, Hear ye the word of the LORD;**

3 Thus saith the Lord GOD; **Woe unto the foolish prophets, that follow their own spirit, and have seen nothing!**

4 O Israel, **thy prophets are like the foxes in the deserts** (Dry Churches).

5 **Ye have not gone up into the gaps,** neither made up the hedge for the house of Israel to stand in the battle in the day of the LORD.

6 **They have seen vanity and lying divination,** saying, The LORD saith: and the LORD hath not sent them: and **they have made others to hope that they would confirm the word.**

7 Have ye not seen a vain vision, and **have ye not spoken a lying divination,** whereas ye say, The LORD saith it; **albeit I have not spoken?**

8 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; **Because ye have spoken vanity, and seen lies,** therefore, behold, **I am against you, saith the Lord GOD.**

9 And **mine hand shall be upon the prophets that see vanity, and that divine lies: they shall not be in the assembly of my people,** neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel, neither shall they enter into the land of Israel; and ye shall know that I am the Lord GOD.

We know the “False Prophets” by their fruits.

Matt 7:15-16

15 **Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing,** but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

16 **Ye shall know them by their fruits.** Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?

There are two kinds of “False Prophets”, those that do it for the money, and those who do not know that they are “False Prophets”. Jesus knows who they are!

Matt 7:22-23

22 **Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name?** and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

23 And **then will I profess unto them, I never knew you:** depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

“True Prophets” of God are disliked by men.

Luke 6:22-23

22 **Blessed are ye, when men shall hate you,** and when they shall separate you from their company, and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of man's sake.

23 Rejoice ye in that day, and leap for joy: for, behold, your reward is great in heaven: **for in the like manner did their fathers unto the prophets.**

“False Prophets” are liked by men because they say what men want to hear.

Luke 6:26

26 Woe unto you, when all men shall speak well of you! for so did their fathers to the false prophets.

We need to ‘test the spirits’, to see if they are of God.

I Jn 4:1-6

1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

2 Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:

3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

4 Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

5 They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world, and the world heareth them.

6 We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.

FALSE PROPHETESSES:

There are “False Prophetesses” just as there are “False Prophets”.

The “False Prophetess” Noadiah along with other “False Prophets” tried to put fear in Nehemiah when he was rebuilding the wall of Jerusalem.

Neh 6:11-14

11 And I said, Should such a man as I flee? and who is there, that, being as I am, would go into the temple to save his life? I will not go in.

12 And, lo, I perceived that God had not sent him; but that he pronounced this prophecy against me: for Tobiah and Sanballat had hired him.

13 Therefore was he hired, that I should be afraid, and do so, and sin, and that they might have matter for an evil report, that they might reproach me.

14 My God, think thou upon Tobiah and Sanballat according to these their works, and on the prophetess Noadiah, and the rest of the prophets, that would have put me in fear.

Other “False Prophetesses”.

Ezek 13:17

17 Likewise, thou son of man, **set thy face against the daughters of thy people, which prophesy out of their own heart; and prophesy thou against them,**

Ezek 13:19

19 **And will ye pollute me among my people** for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, **to slay the souls that should not die, and to save the souls alive that should not live, by your lying to my people that hear your lies?**

Ezek 13:22-23

22 **Because with lies ye have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad; and strengthened the hands of the wicked, that he should not return from his wicked way, by promising him life:**

23 **Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations:** for I will deliver my people out of your hand: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

Rev 2:20-22

20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, **because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants** to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

21 And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.

22 **Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.**

FALSE TEACHERS:

“False Teachers” can be the Pastors / Priests themselves, or those that ‘teach’ in the churches.

Jer 2:8

8 **The priests** said not, Where is the LORD? **and they that handle the law knew me not: the pastors also transgressed against me,** and the prophets prophesied by Baal, and walked after things that do not profit.

Jer 10:21

21 **For the pastors are become brutish, and have not sought the LORD:** therefore they shall not prosper, and all their flocks shall be scattered.

Jer 12:10

10 **Many pastors have destroyed my vineyard,** they have trodden my portion under foot, **they have made my pleasant portion a desolate wilderness.**

Today, many people in the churches themselves want “False Teachers”.

2 Tim 4:3

3 For the time will come when **they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers**, having itching ears;

Some Teach for the money!

Titus 1:10-11

10 **For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers**, specially they of the circumcision: (That are under the Law)

11 Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, **teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake.**

“False Teachers” Teach the Doctrines and Commandments of Men!

2 Pet 2:1

1 But there were false prophets also among the people, even as **there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies**, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

Matt 15:8-9

8 This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me.

9 But in vain they do worship me, **teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.** (the Traditions of men)

Therefore, those in these churches will lose the Wisdom and Understanding of God.

Isa 29:13-14

13 Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near me with their mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far from me, and **their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men:**

14 Therefore, behold, I will proceed to do a marvellous work among this people, even a marvellous work and a wonder: **for the wisdom of their wise men shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent men shall be hid.**

“False Teachers” are also hypocrites.

Rom 2:21-24

21 **Thou therefore which teachest another, teachest thou not thyself?** thou that preachest a man should not steal, dost thou steal?

22 **Thou that sayest a man should not commit adultery, dost thou commit adultery? thou that abhorrest idols, dost thou commit sacrilege?**

23 **Thou that makest thy boast of the law, through breaking the law dishonourest thou God?**

24 **For the name of God is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written.**

TRUE TEACHERS:

'True Teachers' are Called by Jesus.

Eph 4:11

11 **And he gave some**, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and **teachers**;

1 Cor 12:28

28 **And God hath set some in the church**, first apostles, secondarily prophets, **thirdly teachers**, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.

2 Tim 1:11

11 **Whereunto I am appointed** a preacher, and an apostle, and a **teacher** of the Gentiles.

FALSE WITNESSES:

God warns us not to be a "False Witness".

Exod 23:1

1 **Thou shalt not raise a false report: put not thine hand with the wicked to be an unrighteous witness.**

God hates "False Witnesses. They are an abomination to Him!

Prov 6:16

16 **These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him:**

Prov 6:19

19 **A false witness that speaketh lies**, and he that soweth discord among brethren.

A "False Witness" will speak deceit and lies.

Prov 12:17

17 He that speaketh truth sheweth forth righteousness: **but a false witness deceit.**

Prov 14:5

5 A faithful witness will not lie: **but a false witness will utter lies.**

Prov 24:28

28 **Be not a witness against thy neighbour without cause; and deceive not with thy lips.**

A “False Witness” will not go unpunished.

Prov 19:5

5 **A false witness shall not be unpunished, and he that speaketh lies shall not escape.**

Prov 19:28

28 **An ungodly witness scorneth judgment:** and the mouth of the wicked devoureth iniquity.

Prov 21:28

28 **A false witness shall perish:** but the man that heareth speaketh constantly.

Isa 28:17

17 **Judgment also will I lay to the line,** and righteousness to the plummet: and **the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies,** and the waters shall overflow the hiding place. (1 Peter 4:17)

“False Witness” comes from the Heart!

Isa 44:9

9 They that make a graven image are all of them vanity; and their delectable things shall not profit; and **they are their own witnesses; they see not, nor know; that they may be ashamed.**

Matt 15:19

19 **For out of the heart proceed** evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, **false witness,** blasphemies:

TRUE WITNESSES:

‘True Witnesses’ have one thing in common, they lead people to the Lord. (To Salvation)

Prov 14:25

25 **A true witness delivereth souls:** but a deceitful witness speaketh lies.

True Christians cannot give “False Witness” because we have the ‘Witness of God’!

I Jn 5:6-10

6 This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. **And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth.**

7 **For there are three that bear record (Witness) in heaven,** the Father, the Word (Jesus), and the Holy Ghost: **and these three are one.**

8 **And there are three that bear witness in earth**, the spirit, and the water (Those Born of), and the blood (Those Born Again): **and these three agree in one.**

9 **If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son.**

10 **He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record (Witness) that God gave of his Son.**

FALSE BRETHREN:

“False Brethren” are those that sow discord among the “Body of Christ”, and God hates this.

Prov 6:16

16 **These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him:**

Prov 6:19

19 **A false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren.**

“False Brethren” are also those that have no love, and hate their brothers and sisters.

I Jn 2:9-11

9 **He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now.**

10 **He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him.**

11 **But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes.**

I Jn 3:14-15

14 **We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.**

15 **Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him.**

Not everyone that seemingly is doing the work of the Lord, does it for the right motives.

Jer 48:10

10 **Cursed be he that doeth the work of the LORD deceitfully (Or Negligently), and cursed be he that keepeth back his sword from blood.**

We should listen to only those Brethren that ‘consistently’ do the Lord’s Will. Even if others seem to be moving in the ‘Gifts of the Spirit’!

Matt 7:21-23

21 **Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.**

22 **Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?**

23 **And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.**

Paul mentions the problems he had in his journeys; one being “False Brethren”.
(Paul said he was)

2 Cor 11:26

26 In journeyings often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils by mine own countrymen, in perils by the heathen, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, **in perils among false brethren;**

Gal 2:4

4 **And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty (Set Free) which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage (of the Law):**

Some of the “False Brethren” in the Church are those who have ‘fallen back’ and have become ‘Transgressors’!

Gal 2:16-18

16 **Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ,** even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

17 **But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, is therefore Christ the minister of sin?** God forbid.

18 **For if I build again the things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor.**

Isa 1:28

28 **And the destruction of the transgressors and of the sinners shall be together,** and they that forsake the LORD shall be consumed.

And the ‘Transgressors’ are those “False Brethren” who have returned to the ‘Flesh’!

Gal 5:19-26

19 **Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these;** Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,

20 **Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,**

21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, **as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.**

22 **But the fruit of the Spirit is** love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

23 Meekness, temperance: **against such there is no law.**

24 **And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.**

25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

26 **Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.**

James 4:5

5 Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, **The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy?**

Eph 5:3-7

3 **But** fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, **let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints;**

4 Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, **which are not convenient:** but rather giving of thanks.

5 **For this ye know, that no** whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, **hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.**

6 **Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience.**

7 **Be not ye therefore partakers with them.**

Many "False Brethren" have crept into the Church.

Jude 3-4

3 Beloved, when **I** gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, **it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith** which was once delivered unto the saints.

4 **For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation,** ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

Jude 8

8 **Likewise also these filthy dreamers** defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

Jude 16

16 These are murmurers, complainers, **walking after their own lusts;** and their mouth speaketh great swelling words, **having men's persons in admiration because of advantage.**

Jude 18-19

18 **How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.**

19 **These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the Spirit.**

Phil 3:18-20

18 **(For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ:**

19 **Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.)**

20 **For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:**

Paul gives us this commandment on how we are to react to “False Brethren”!

II Th 3:6

6 **Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition which he received of us.**

Rom 16:17

17 **Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them.**

TRUE BRETHREN:

The ‘True Brethren’ are those that **do** the Will of God the Father!

When Jesus spoke to the people, He explained who His Brethren were.

Matt 12:46-50

46 **While he yet talked to the people, behold, his mother and his brethren stood without, desiring to speak with him.**

47 **Then one said unto him, Behold, thy mother and thy brethren stand without, desiring to speak with thee.**

48 **But he answered and said unto him that told him, Who is my mother? and who are my brethren?**

49 **And he stretched forth his hand toward his disciples, and said, Behold my mother and my brethren!**

50 **For whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother.**

‘True Brethren’ dwell together in unity!

Ps 133:1

1 **Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!**

‘True Brethren’ walk in the Truth, and help those that are also walking in Truth.

3 Jn 1:3-10

3 For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth.

4 I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.

5 Beloved, thou doest faithfully whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers;

6 Which have borne witness of thy charity before the church: whom if thou bring forward on their journey after a godly sort, thou shalt do well:

7 Because that for his name's sake they went forth, taking nothing of the Gentiles.

8 We therefore ought to receive such, that we might be fellowhelpers to the truth.

“False Brethren” do not.

9 I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who loveth to have the preeminence among them, receiveth us not.

10 Wherefore, if I come, I will remember his deeds which he doeth, prating against us with malicious words: and not content therewith, neither doth he himself receive the brethren, and forbiddeth them that would, and casteth them out of the church.

Isa 66:5

5 Hear the word of the LORD, ye that tremble at his word; Your brethren that hated you, that cast you out for my name's sake, said, Let the LORD be glorified: but he shall appear to your joy, and they shall be ashamed.

As ‘True Brethren’, we need to Pray for these “False Brethren”, and when opportunity arises, convert them back to Jesus. (Psalm 51:10-13)

James 5:19-20

19 Brethren, if any of you do err from the truth, and one convert him;

20 Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.

VI. YOU WILL DENOUNCE FALSE DOCTRINE AND HERESY:

(After his fall from grace, Evangelist Jimmy Swaggert was asked if he would do anything different than before. He said, when ‘denouncing’ things, he would have done it with more **LOVE**)

We need to remember this if God Calls us to Rebuke others; it ‘must’ be done in **LOVE!**

FALSE DOCTRINE:

“False Doctrine” although easily recognized, is becoming more and more prevalent in today’s Christian Churches. This is because there are many ‘unbelievers’ in the Christian Churches that want to hear what makes them feel good. (2 Tim. 4:3)

Unfortunately, many Pastors / Priests are telling them what they want to hear!

These ‘so-called’ Christian Churches that continue to expound this “False Doctrine” will not be going in the ‘Translation of the Church’. Some of the Leaders and some of the body may go, but not these churches in general, unless they Repent!

They are part of the ‘Apostasy’ in the last days. (2 Thess. 2:3)

They will become just like the Cultic Churches which totally consist of “False Doctrine”, unless they Repent!

The Bible calls this “False Doctrine” - lying words!!

Jer 7:8-10

8 **Behold, ye trust in lying words**, that cannot profit.

9 Will ye steal, murder, and commit adultery, and swear falsely, and burn incense unto Baal, and walk after other gods whom ye know not;

10 **And come and stand before me in this house, which is called by my name, and say, We are delivered (Saved) to do all these abominations?**

Isa 59:12-16

12 **For our transgressions are multiplied before thee, and our sins testify against us:** for our transgressions are with us; **and as for our iniquities, we know them;**

13 **In transgressing and lying against the LORD**, and departing away from our God, speaking oppression and revolt, **conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood.**

14 **And judgment is turned away backward**, and justice standeth afar off: **for truth is fallen in the street**, and equity cannot enter.

15 **Yea, truth faileth; and he that departeth from evil** (Those that Fear the Lord) **maketh himself a prey:** and the LORD saw it, **and it displeased him that there was no judgment.**

16 **And he saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor:** therefore his arm brought salvation unto him; and his righteousness, it sustained him.

“False Doctrine” is made up of the Commandments of Men, particularly Religious Leaders!

Matt 16:6

6 **Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.**

Matt 16:11-12

11 How is it that ye do not understand that I spake it not to you concerning bread, that ye should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees?

12 **Then understood they how that he bade them not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.**

Matt 15:9

9 **But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.**

Col 2:20-22

20 **Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ** from the rudiments of the world, **why**, as though living in the world, **are ye subject to ordinances,**

21 (Touch not; taste not; handle not;

22 Which all are to perish with the using;) **after the commandments and doctrines of men?**

Eph 4:14

14 **That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;**

1 Tim 1:9-10

9 **Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient,** for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers,

10 For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, **and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine;**

Other “False Doctrine” is a result of listening to ‘seducing spirits’ and ‘doctrines of demons’!

1 Tim 4:1-2

- 1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, **giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;**
 2 **Speaking lies in hypocrisy;** having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

Heb 13:9

9 **Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines.** For it is a good thing that the heart be established with grace; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein.

Those that do not abide in the “Doctrine of Christ”:

II Jn 1:9-10

9 **Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son.**
 10 **If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed:**

The churches in Pergamos and Thyatira are examples of churches with “False Doctrine”:

Rev 2:14-16

14 **But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam,** who taught Balac to cast a stumblingblock before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication.
 15 **So hast thou also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate.**
 16 **Repent; or else** I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.

Rev 2:20

20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because **thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants** to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

Rev 2:24

24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest **in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine,** and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; **I will put upon you none other burden.**

(Read the Book “The Seven Golden Candlesticks” by Timothy II)

HERESY:

What is “Heresy”?

The Dictionary says:

A belief contrary to that which is commonly accepted or maintained by authority.

The Bible says:

HERESY:

haireisis ^139^ denotes (a) "a choosing, choice" (from haireomai, "to choose"); then, "that which is chosen," and hence, "**an opinion**," especially a self-willed opinion, which is substituted for submission to the power of truth, **and leads to division and the formation of sects**, such erroneous opinions are frequently the outcome of personal preference or the prospect of advantage;
(from Vine's Expository Dictionary of Biblical Words)
(Copyright (C) 1985, Thomas Nelson Publishers)

“Heresies” are ‘works of the Flesh’!

Gal 5:19-20

19 **Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these;** Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,

20 **Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,**

There are ‘False Teachers’ that bring “Heresy” into the Church, and many follow them.

2 Pet 2:1-2

1 But there were false prophets also among the people, even as **there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies**, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

2 **And many shall follow their pernicious ways;** by reason of whom **the way of truth shall be evil spoken of.** (John 14:6)

‘False Heresy’:

Paul said the ‘unbelievers’ call his way “Heresy”.

Acts 24:14

14 But this I confess unto thee, **that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers**, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets:

After we admonish (reprimand, warn, caution) a “Heretic” twice, we are to reject him/her!

Titus 3:10-11

10 **A man that is an heretick** after the first and second admonition **reject;**

11 **Knowing that he that is such is subverted, and sinneth**, being condemned of himself.

Speaking out “Heresies”, causes Division (Disunion) in the churches.

Many times these “Heresies” are about money!

Titus 1:10-11

10 **For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision:**

11 **Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses (churches), teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake.**

.In the Bible: Divisions - Dichostasia in the Greek, means - dissension, sedition, disunion, division.

We are to watch for those who cause ‘Divisions’

Rom 16:17-18

17 Now I beseech you, brethren, **mark them which cause divisions** (Dichostasia) **and offences** contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them.

18 **For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly;** and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple.

1 Cor 3:3

3 **For ye are yet carnal:** for whereas **there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions,** are ye not carnal, and walk as men?

James 3:14-16

14 **But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts,** glory not, and **lie not against the truth.**

15 **This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish.**

16 **For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.**

Divisions lead to Sects.

Acts 5:17

17 Then the high priest rose up, and all they that were with him, **(which is the sect of the Sadducees,)** and were filled with indignation,

Acts 15:5

5 But there rose up certain of **the sect of the Pharisees** which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command them to keep the law of Moses.

Acts 26:5

5 Which knew me from the beginning, if they would testify, that after the most **straitest sect of our religion I lived a Pharisee.**

Even Christianity was spoken of as a Sect.

Acts 24:5

5 For we have found this man (Paul) a pestilent fellow, and a mover of sedition among all the Jews throughout the world, and a ringleader of **the sect of the Nazarenes: Acts 28:22**

22 But we desire to hear of thee what thou thinkest: for **as concerning this sect, we know that every where it is spoken against.**

Denominations are much like Sects!

A PARABLE FROM THE LORD:

(The following is a Parable that was given to Timothy II by the Lord on June 19, 1990)

WHO CAUSED DENOMINATIONS? - SATAN, MAN, OR GOD?

SATAN: Did Satan cause Denominations?

If he did, he would be dividing his kingdom, because the Christian Churches within Denominations, even though they may not get along with each other, speak the 'word of God'.

All that Satan is against, such as Salvations, Deliverances, Healings, etc., take place in many of these churches; which make them part of the 'Kingdom of God'.

Satan can have no part in the 'Kingdom of God', otherwise he would be divided!

Luke 11:17-20

17 But he, knowing their thoughts, said unto them, **Every kingdom divided (Diamerizo) against itself is brought to desolation; and a house divided against a house falleth.**

In the Bible: Diamerizo in the Greek, means - Thoroughly Divided or partitioned.

18 **If Satan also be divided against himself, how shall his kingdom stand?**

because ye say that I cast out devils through Beelzebub.

19 And if I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your sons cast them out? therefore shall they be your judges.

20 **But if I with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt the kingdom of God is come upon you.**

Satan's kingdom would be divided if he allowed devils to be cast out in his house.

Matt 12:25-28

25 And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, **Every kingdom divided (Merizo) against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand:**

In the Bible: Divided - Merizo in the Greek, means - to differ, to disunite, to part, divide.

26 **And if Satan cast out Satan, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand?**

27 And if I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your children cast them out? therefore they shall be your judges.

28 **But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.**

Satan cannot cast out Satan or else he would be divided against himself. That is why Satan has his own churches (the synagogue of Satan) which are the Cultic Churches. (Revelation 2: 9)

They might use the name of 'Jesus' in some of these churches, but they don't know Him.

MAN: Did Man cause Denominations?

If Denominations came from man, then they would not have lasted throughout history!

Acts 5:38

38 And now I say unto you, Refrain from these men, and let them alone: **for if this counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought:**

Denominations, if from man, are "works of the flesh".

Gal 5:19-20

19 Now **the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these;** Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,

20 Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, **seditions, heresies,**

Heresies or Divisions **are** the "works of the flesh".

GOD: Did God cause Denominations?

If Denominations are from God, then they would be in order. There would be no envy and strife or Divisions!

Gal 5:26

26 Let us not be desirous of vain glory, **provoking one another, envying one another.**

If Denominations are of man they would not last, if they are of God they could not be overthrown.

Acts 5:39

39 **But if it be of God, ye cannot overthrow it;** lest haply ye be found even to fight against God.

Yet, Denominations can and will be overthrown!

THE ANSWER FROM THE LORD:

Man 'caused' Denominations, but God 'allowed' them. That is why they have lasted. He has allowed them, so that He can make manifest the 'approved' in the "Body of Christ" in the last days.

In other words, so He can show who is the "True Church" the "Body of Christ" in these last days!

There will be no Denominations nor Divisions in His Final 'Glorious' Church. It will be Holy and without blemish, not having spot or wrinkle! Amen!

CONFIRMATION FROM THE WORD:**1 Cor 11:18-19**

18 For first of all, when ye come together in the church, **I hear that there be divisions among you;** and I partly believe it.

19 **For there must be also heresies among you, that they which are approved may be made manifest among you.**

And God wants no Divisions in the "Body of Christ"!

1 Cor 1:10

10 **Now I beseech you, brethren,** by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and **that there be no divisions (Schisma) among you;** but **that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.**

In the Bible: Divisions - in the Greek, is Schisma - meaning Gap or schism or split.

STANDING IN THE GAP:

Because of these Divisions in Denominations, the Lord is raising up people to stand in the Gap (Schisma). The Messenger of God and his Company will stand in the Gap (Schisma) for the "Body of Christ".

Isa 58:12

12 **And they that shall be of thee (the Company) shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and thou shalt be called, The repairer of the breach (Gap), The restorer of paths to dwell in.**

Jer 18:15

15 **Because my people hath forgotten me,** they have burned incense to vanity, and **they have caused them to stumble in their ways from the ancient paths, to walk in paths, in a way not cast up;**

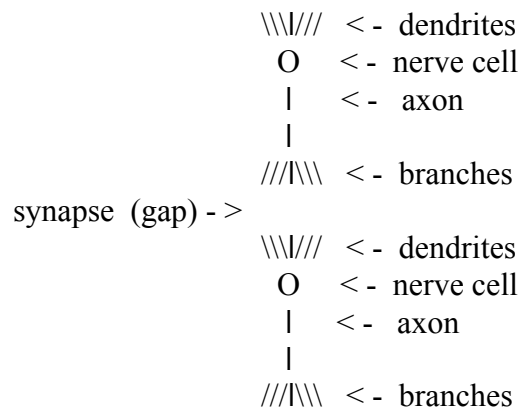
AN EXAMPLE OF STANDING IN THE GAP:

The Lord gave Timothy II an example of why there needs to be someone to stand in the Gap for the "Body of Christ".

The Body of Christ - as an example made up of Nerve Cells called Neurons:

If you look at the make-up of “Nerve Cells”, you can see that in order for a “Nerve Impulse” to conduct itself down the Neuron: it is dependent on the Neuron being complete (the dendrites, nerve cell, axon, and branches). It also depends on the other Neurons being in order, so that the Nerve Impulse will jump the Synapse or Gap between the Neurons.

A Nerve Cell
(Neuron)



Other observations:

The “Nerve Impulse” carries only in one direction. (Such as the impulses or messages from God through the Body of Christ).

The synapse (Gap), is where there is an intimate relationship between nerve processes. (Like the relationship between those in the Body of Christ).

When a Neuron or someone in the Body of Christ is out of order, the Gap widens.

Therefore, there is a need to stand in the Gap to bring the Body of Christ together when there is a widening of the Gap.

Fatigue also sets in this Gap. Thus, we must encourage one another and hold each other up when we get tired, in order to keep the Impulses or messages from becoming distorted.

This will also help allow the Impulses or messages from God to get to where they need to go in the “Body of Christ”.

VII. SOME WILL DEPART FROM THE FAITH - LET THEM GO:

In these Last Days, many people will leave the Church.

The Lord has said:

Let them go, because they are not part of the True “Body of Christ”.

1 Tim 4:1-3

1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that **in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;**

2 **Speaking lies in hypocrisy;** having their conscience seared with a hot iron;

3 **Forbidding to marry** (Cults and Homosexuals), **and commanding to abstain from meats** (animal rights activists), which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.

These are ‘Deceivers, Antichrists and Scorners’ that must go in order for the True “Body of Christ” to be revealed.

Titus 1:10

10 **For there are many** unruly and vain talkers and **deceivers**, specially they of the circumcision:

II Jn 1:7

7 **For many deceivers** are entered into the world, who **confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.**

They must be cast out because they will not receive reproof or rebuke!

Prov 22:10

10 **Cast out the scorner**, and contention shall go out; yea, strife and reproach shall cease.

Prov 9:7-8

7 **He that reproveth a scorner getteth to himself shame: and he that rebuketh a wicked man getteth himself a blot.**

8 **Reprove not a scorner**, lest he hate thee: rebuke a wise man, and he will love thee.

Prov 13:1

1 A wise son heareth his father's instruction: but **a scorner heareth not rebuke.**

Prov 15:12

12 **A scorner loveth not one that reproveth him:** neither will he go unto the wise.

Prov 19:29

29 **Judgments are prepared for scorers,** and stripes for the back of fools.

Prov 21:24

24 **Proud and haughty scorner is his name,** who dealeth in proud wrath.

These ‘Deceivers, Antichrists and Scorers’ are part of the ‘Great Apostasy’ or ‘Falling Away’ of professing Christians, that **must** take place before the ‘Second Coming’ of Jesus.

II Th 2:3

3 **Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first,** and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

I Jn 2:18-19

18 Little children, it is the last time: and as ye **have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time.**

19 **They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would no doubt have continued with us: but they went out, that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us.**

It is important to get rid of these ‘Deceivers, Antichrists and Scorers’, because they are not part of the light of God, and cause darkness in the True “Body of Christ”!

Luke 11:33-36

33 **No man, when he hath lighted a candle, putteth it in a secret place,** neither under a bushel, **but on a candlestick, that they which come in may see the light.**

34 **The light of the body is the eye:** therefore when thine eye is single, thy whole body also is full of light; **but when thine eye is evil, thy body also is full of darkness.**

35 **Take heed** therefore that the light which is in thee **be not darkness.**

36 **If thy whole body therefore be full of light, having no part dark, the whole shall be full of light, as when the bright shining of a candle doth give thee light.**

VIII. YOU WILL APPOINT NEW LEADERS:

“Appointing New Leaders” is an Awesome responsibility, and can only be done through the leading of God the Holy Spirit.

2 Tim 2:2

2 **And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.**

You cannot “Appoint New Leaders” without ‘Judging’ the church.

1 Pet 4:17

17 **For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God:** and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that obey not the gospel of God?

We are called to ‘Judge’ (not criticize) and “Appoint”.
(Read the ‘Study Guide’ on “Criticism vs. Judgement” by Timothy II).

2 Chr 19:5-11

5 **And he set judges in the land** throughout all the fenced cities of Judah, city by city,

6 **And said to the judges, Take heed what ye do: for ye judge not for man, but for the LORD, who is with you in the judgment.**

7 **Wherefore now let the fear of the LORD be upon you; take heed and do it:** for there is no iniquity with the LORD our God, nor respect of persons, nor taking of gifts.

8 **Moreover in Jerusalem did Jehoshaphat set of the Levites, and of the priests, and of the chief of the fathers** (Must be Called) of Israel, **for the judgment of the LORD,** and for controversies, when they returned to Jerusalem.

9 **And he charged them, saying, Thus shall ye do in the fear of the LORD, faithfully, and with a perfect heart.**

You must have the “Spirit of the Fear of the Lord”, in order to ‘Judge’ and “Appoint” for the Lord. (Read the book on “The Seven Spirits of God” by Timothy II).

10 **And what cause soever shall come to you** of your brethren that dwell in their cities, between blood and blood, between law and commandment, statutes and judgments, **ye shall even warn them that they trespass not against the LORD,** and so wrath come upon you, and upon your brethren: this do, and ye shall not trespass.

The Messenger will only ‘Judge’ in the ‘Spiritual Matters’ of the Church.

11 And, behold, Amariah **the chief priest is over you in all matters of the LORD** (Spiritual Matters); and Zebadiah the son of Ishmael, **the ruler of the house** of Judah, **for all the king's matters** (Physical Matters): also the Levites shall be officers before you. **Deal courageously, and the LORD shall be with the good.**

There are two kinds of 'Matters of Accountability' in the Church:

1. Spiritual (The Matters of the Lord) - Which is the role of the Apostles/Messengers.
 2. Physical (The King's Matters) - Which is the role of the Pastors / Priests.
- (Read the Study Guide on "Accountability" by Timothy II).

'Judgment' is needed in the Church today!

Isa 59:14-15

14 **And judgment is turned away backward**, and justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter.

15 Yea, truth faileth; and **he that departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw it, and it displeased him that there was no judgment.**

That is why God is restoring His 'Judges' as at the first!

Isa 1:26-27

26 **And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning** (not Psychologists): afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city.

Then those that have been converted will be restored to righteousness, instead of floundering and 'falling backwards' as they are today!.

27 **Zion shall be redeemed with judgment, and her converts with righteousness.**

GENERAL RULES FOR JUDGING:

The following Scriptures give some general rules for 'Judging' the Church, and why it must be done only by those that are Called, and through the leading of God the Holy Spirit!

1 Cor 4:1-6

1 **Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.**

2 Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.

3 But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged of you, or of man's judgment: yea, **I judge not mine own self.**

4 **For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but he that judgeth me is the Lord.**

5 **Therefore judge nothing before the time**, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God.

6 And these things, brethren, **I have in a figure transferred to myself and to Apollos for your sakes; that ye might learn in us not to think of men above that which is written, that no one of you be puffed up for one against another.**

The Messengers do not Judge each other, but only the ‘Spiritual Matters’ of the Church. This may or may not include individuals!

There can be no pride, strife, or envy involved in ‘Judgment’. (2 Timothy 2:24-26)

1 Cor 4:9

9 **For I think that God hath set forth us the apostles last**, as it were appointed to death: for we are made a spectacle unto the world, and to angels, and to men.

1 Cor 4:15

15 **For though ye have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet have ye not many fathers:** for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel.

Pastors / Priests need to Judge the ‘Physical Matters’ of the Church in the Spirit of Wisdom.

1 Cor 6:2-5

2 **Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world?** and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters?

3 Know ye not that we shall judge angels? **how much more things that pertain to this life?**

4 **If then ye have judgments of things pertaining to this life**, set them to judge who are least esteemed in the church.

5 **I speak to your shame.** Is it so, that there is not a wise man among you? **no, not one that shall be able to judge between his brethren?**

If we would ‘Judge’ ourselves, we would not have to be ‘Judged’ by the Lord. Also, chastening follows ‘Judgment’, if it is negative.

1 Cor 11:31-32

31 **For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged.**

32 **But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord**, that we should not be condemned with the world.

Do not ‘Judge’ unless you are ‘Called’ to do so!

Matt 7:1-2

1 **Judge not, that ye be not judged.**

2 **For with what judgment ye judge, ye shall be judged:** and with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you again.

This means do not ‘Judge’ or criticize one another, or God will ‘Judge’ you with the same measure. Leave the ‘Judging’ to those that are ‘Called’ to do it.

Matt 7:5

5 **Thou hypocrite**, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

Rom 2:1-3

1 **Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest:** for wherein thou judgest another, thou condemnest thyself; for thou that judgest doest the same things.

2 **But we are sure that the judgment of God is according to truth against them which commit such things.**

God gives us a warning.

3 **And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God?**

Rom 1:32

32 **Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them.**

Speaking evil of your Brethren, makes you a ‘Judge’ of your Brethren and the Law (Word). You are no longer a ‘doer’ of the Word, but a ‘Judge’. (James 1:22)

James 4:11-12

11 **Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of his brother, and judgeth his brother, speaketh evil of the law, and judgeth the law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge.**

12 **There is one lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy: who art thou that judgest another?**

Once we understand the importance of not ‘Judging’ anyone or anything unless you are ‘Called’; and when Called, doing so in the “Fear of the Lord”, makes us ready to “Appoint New Leaders”!

APPOINTING NEW LEADERS:

There is a great need to “Appoint New Leaders”; however, this must be done through the leading of God the Holy Spirit. This is because God is raising up His own Leaders in these last days!

Isa 9:16

16 **For the leaders of this people cause them to err; and they that are led of them are destroyed.**

Matt 23:13

13 **But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites!** for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in yourselves, neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in.

Luke 11:23

23 **He that is not with me is against me: and he that gathereth not with me scattereth.**

Jer 23:1-4

1 **Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture!** saith the LORD.

2 **Therefore thus saith the LORD God of Israel against the pastors that feed my people; Ye have scattered my flock, and driven them away, and have not visited them:** (Through your Denominations and Traditions and Commandments of men) behold, I will visit upon you the evil of your doings, saith the LORD.

3 **And I will gather the remnant of my flock out of all countries whither I have driven them, and will bring them again to their folds;** and they shall be fruitful and increase.

4 **And I will set up shepherds over them which shall feed them:** and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, neither shall they be lacking, saith the LORD.

Jer 3:14-15

14 **Turn, O backsliding children,** saith the LORD; for I am married unto you: and I will take you one of a city, and two of a family, and I will bring you to Zion:

15 **And I will give you pastors according to mine heart,** which shall feed you with knowledge and understanding.

Beware of Pride! This is true of Pastors / Priests and those Called to do the “Appointing”!

Dan 5:20

20 **But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him:**

The Lord is with us in the “Appointing”! When we “Appoint”, we ‘Anoint’!

1 Sam 15:10-11

10 Then came the word of the LORD unto Samuel, saying,

11 **It repenteth me that I have set up Saul to be king: for he is turned back from following me, and hath not performed my commandments.** And it grieved Samuel; and he cried unto the LORD all night.

1 Sam 16:1

1 And the LORD said unto Samuel, How long wilt thou mourn for Saul, seeing **I have rejected him from reigning over Israel? fill thine horn with oil, and go**, I will send thee to Jesse the Bethlehemite: **for I have provided me a king** among his sons.

1 Sam 16:12-14

12 And he sent, and brought him in. Now he was ruddy, and withal of a beautiful countenance, and goodly to look to. **And the LORD said, Arise, anoint him: for this is he.**

13 **Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him** in the midst of his brethren: **and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward.** So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

14 **But the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul**, and an evil spirit from the LORD troubled him.

CONCLUSION TO APPOINTING NEW LEADERS:

God “Appoints” whomsoever He will!

Dan 5:21

21 And he was driven from the sons of men; and his heart was made like the beasts, and his dwelling was with the wild asses: they fed him with grass like oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven; **till he knew that the most high God ruled in the kingdom of men, and that he appointeth over it whomsoever he will.**

2 Tim 1:11

11 **Whereunto I am appointed** a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles.

THE RESULT OF THIS PROPHECY TO TIMOTHY II:

I am overcome with the Holiness of the Lord!

Jer 23:9

9 Mine heart within me is broken because of the prophets; all my bones shake; **I am like a drunken man, and like a man whom wine hath overcome, because of the LORD, and because of the words of his holiness.**

Jer 23:11

11 **For both prophet and priest are profane; yea, in my house have I found their wickedness, saith the LORD.** (Galatians 6:7-8)

IX. YOU WILL SEE THAT MY BODY WILL HUMBLE THEMSELVES BEFORE ME:

In order to “Humble” ourselves, we need to know what this means. Today, because of the influence of Psychology, we really do not know what the word means!

The following is the meaning of the word “Humble”:

In the Dictionary:

hum·ble

1. Marked by meekness or modesty in behavior, attitude, or spirit; not arrogant or prideful. **2.** Showing deferential or submissive respect. **3.** Low in rank, quality, or station; unpretentious or lowly.

hum·bled,

1. To curtail or destroy the pride of; humiliate. **2.** To cause to be meek or modest in spirit. **3.** To give a lower condition or station to; abase..

In the Hebrew:

7817 shachach (shaw-khakh');
a primitive root; to sink or depress (reflexive or causative):

KJV-- bend, bow (down), bring (cast) down, couch, humbleself, be (bring) low, stoop.

6035 `anav (aw-nawv');
or [by intermixture with 6041] `anayv (aw-nawv'); from 6031; depressed (figuratively),

in mind (gentle) or circumstances (needy, especially saintly):

KJV-- humble, lowly, meek, poor.

6038 `anavah (an-aw-vaw');
from 6035; condescension, human and subjective (modesty), or divine and objective

(clemency):

KJV-- gentleness, humility, meekness. [q]

In the Greek:

5013 tapeinoo (tap-i-no'-o);
from 5011; to depress; figuratively, to humiliate (in condition or heart):

KJV-- abase, bring low, humble (self).

5012 tapeinophrosune (tap-i-nof-ros-oo'-nay);
from a compound of 5011 and the base of 5424; humiliation of mind, i.e. modesty:

KJV-- humbleness of mind, humility (of mind, loneliness (of mind).

5011 tapeinos (tap-i-nos');
from 5011; to depress; figuratively, to humiliate (in condition or heart):

of uncertain derivation; depressed, i.e. (figuratively) humiliated (in circumstances or disposition):

KJV-- base, cast down, humble, of low degree (estate), lowly.

God hates Pride! That is why He is sending His Messenger to lead the way for the “Body of Christ” to “Humble” themselves before Him!

Prov 6:16-19

- 16 **These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven** are an abomination unto him:
 17 **A proud look**, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood,
 18 An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief,
 19 A false witness that speaketh lies, **and he that soweth discord among brethren.**

This leading by the Messenger must be done through the “Fear of the Lord”.
 (Read the Book on “The Seven Spirits of God” by Timothy II).

Prov 8:13

- 13 **The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy**, and the evil way, and the froward mouth (wayward, obstinate), **do I hate.**

Isa 2:10-17

- 10 **Enter into the rock** (Jesus), **and hide thee in the dust** (humble yourselves), **for fear of the LORD**, and for the glory of his majesty.
 11 **The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down**, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day.
 12 **For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low:**
 13 **And upon all** the cedars of Lebanon, **that are high and lifted up**, and upon all the oaks of Bashan,
 14 **And upon all** the high mountains, and upon all the hills **that are lifted up**,
 15 And upon every high tower, and upon every fenced wall,
 16 And upon all the ships of Tarshish, and upon all pleasant pictures.
 17 **And the loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the haughtiness of men shall be made low: and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day.** (2 Peter 3:10-13)

Isa 25:11-12

- 11 And he shall spread forth his hands in the midst of them, as he that swimmeth spreadeth forth his hands to swim: **and he shall bring down their pride together with the spoils of their hands.**
 12 **And the fortress of the high fort of thy walls shall he bring down, lay low, and bring to the ground, even to the dust.**

Isa 26:5-6

5 **For he bringeth down them that dwell on high; the lofty city, he layeth it low; he layeth it low, even to the ground; he bringeth it even to the dust.**

6 **The foot shall tread it down, even the feet of the poor, and the steps of the needy.**

Isa 32:19

19 **When it shall hail, coming down on the forest;** and the city shall be low in a low place. (Judgment on the People) (Isaiah 28:17)

Being “Humble in spirit” and “Fearing the Lord”, are the True Riches of God.

Prov 16:19

19 **Better it is to be of an humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud.**

Prov 22:4

4 **By humility and the fear of the LORD are riches, and honour, and life.**

God will not hear us unless we do “Humble” ourselves.

Ps 66:18

18 **If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me:**

Isa 59:2

2 **But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.**

John 9:31

31 **Now we know that God heareth not sinners:** but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.

1 Pet 3:12

12 **For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers:** but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil.

Therefore, “Humble” yourselves!

1 Pet 5:5

5 **Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.**

The ‘Good News’!

Isa 57:15

15 **For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.**

Isa 66:2

2 For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the LORD: but **to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word.**

Isa 62:12

12 **And they shall call them, The holy people, The redeemed of the LORD:** and thou shalt be called, Sought out, A city not forsaken. (The results of Judgment)

How to Humble Yourself

The following Chart on “How to Humble Yourself”, has been revealed by God the Holy Spirit to Timothy II, in order to explain the various levels there are in being “Humble”. By placing these levels on a chart with a thermometer, we can easily recognize when we are moving in one direction or the other.

Instead of just saying we are “Humble”, God would have us to know when we are beginning to become Proud or when we are becoming Depressed. Thus we can begin to do something about it before it is too late.

The middle of the chart is the balanced level of the thermometer and is where we are when we are “Humble in spirit” and have proper Pride and Self Respect. This is when we are in God’s Will. The top level of the thermometer is when we have “A Haughty spirit”, and become Arrogant and Full of Pride. These are the things that God Hates. The lower level of the thermometer is when we have “Total Humiliation”, have no Self Respect, and have gone into deep Depression and Withdrawal. Most would go to a Psychiatrist when this happens, but God would have us to know, that He is the one that will heal us.

The advantage of having varying degrees of levels on the thermometer, is so that we can begin to see what direction we may be headed and do something about it.

This chart will be used by the Messenger of God, when seeing that the “Body of Christ” will “Humble” themselves before God.

Along with some related Scriptures, the Chart also has a page on the meanings of Humble, Depressed, Depression, Self Esteem, and Self Respect.

The reasons for these explanations, are that with the influence that Psychology has played on our understanding of these terms, we have misunderstood their meanings.

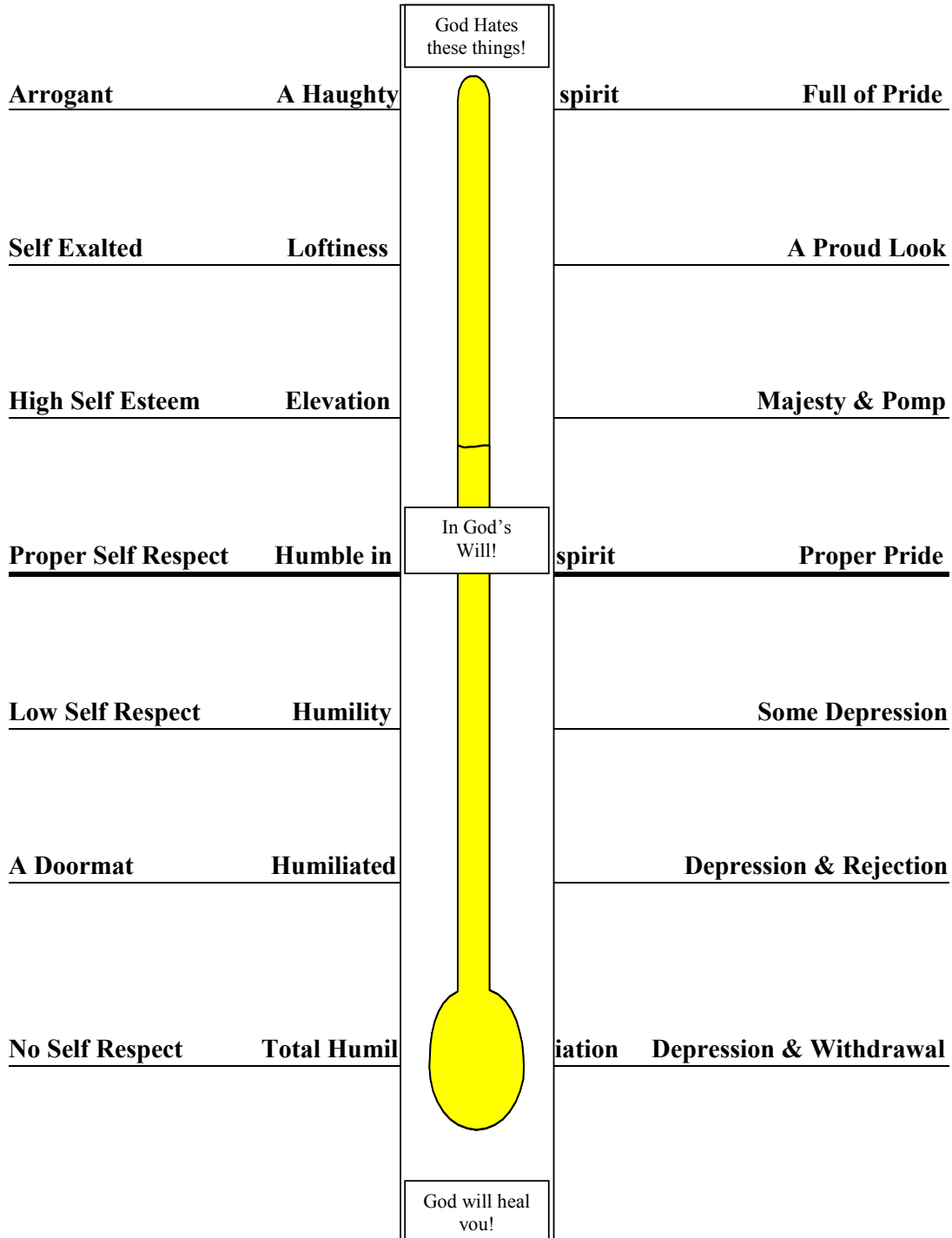
One of these misunderstandings is that all Depression is bad. It is not! In fact, Humility and Depression go hand in hand, and a little keeps us humble. Also, a little Pride is not all bad. It can give us the motivation to do a good job in our work for the Lord.

The term Self Esteem used by Psychologists often leads us to pride, therefore, a better term is Self Respect. Most of these terms are what we have learned in school, and we have lost the true explanation of their meaning.

I pray that God will open up your hearts and minds to the meaningful use of this Chart.

How to Humble Yourself

Prov 16:18 Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.
Prov 29:23 A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.



James 4:10 Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.
1 Pet 5:6 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:

HUMBLE:**Hebrew:**

8217 shaphal (shaw-fawl') Depressed: literally or figuratively, base, lowly.

8213 shaphel (shaw-fale') To depress or sink, humiliate, abase, cast down, make or put low.

7817 shachach (shaw-khakh') Depressed, cast down, humble self.

6038 anavah (an-aw-vaw') Humility, gentleness, meekness, modesty.

6035 anav (aw-nawv') Depressed in mind or circumstances, needy, especially saintly, lowly, meek, poor.

Not proud or arrogant, modest. Low in importance, status or condition. Courteously respectful. Insignificant, inferior, submissive. To destroy the independence or will of.

DEPRESSED:**English:** Dictionary

Sad and gloomy, downcast, pressed down, lower than general, economic hardship or poverty.

(Psychiatry) Suffering from depression.

DEPRESSION:**English:** Dictionary

The state of being depressed.

(Psychiatry) Condition of general emotional dejection and withdrawal.

SELF ESTEEM:**English:** Dictionary

Self respect.

Older Dictionary:

Esteem of oneself; The act of thinking favorably of oneself.

Phil 2:3 Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each **esteem** other better than themselves.

SELF RESPECT:**English:** Dictionary

Proper esteem or regard for the dignity of one's character.

Older Dictionary:

Proper pride and esteem for oneself.

Ps 138:6 Though the LORD be high, yet hath he **respect** unto the lowly: but the proud he knoweth afar off.

LITERALLY ON THEIR KNEES IN AMERICA - NOT OTHER COUNTRIES:

God wants us in America to literally 'get on our knees' when we Worship Him. This is because we have gotten so far away from Him, that we need to bow down to Worship Him to remind us of who HE is! This requires "Humility", a forgotten virtue in America today!

In other countries, particularly third world countries, people are already "Humble" due to their circumstances; so they don't need to further "Humble" themselves.

I believe this is why there are so many 'salvations, miracles, healings and signs & wonders', happening in these other countries.

In the churches in America:

We in the churches in America, need to "Humble" ourselves. In the Hebrew, 3665 "kana" means to 'bend the knee'. Therefore, we need to bend our knees, pray, seek God's face, and Repent, before God will forgive our sins and heal our land!!

2 Chr 7:14-16

14 **If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble (3665 kana) themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.**

15 **Now mine eyes shall be open, and mine ears attent unto the prayer that is made in this place.**

Then God will sanctify the churches!

16 **For now have I chosen and sanctified this house, that my name may be there for ever: and mine eyes and mine heart shall be there perpetually.**

This is a song we sing in the churches in America, but few actually do it!

Ps 95:6

6 **O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.**

Thank God that a few churches such as the Catholic Church do have a place to kneel. The Lord has declared that one day, every knee shall bow unto Him, so we need to honor Him by doing it NOW!

Isa 45:23

23 I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, **That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.**

Rom 14:11

11 **For it is written,** As I live, saith the Lord, **every knee shall bow to me,** and every tongue shall confess to God.

Phil 2:10

10 **That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,** of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

Daniel gives us an example of being “Humble” in prayer by kneeling three times a day.

Dan 6:10

10 Now when **Daniel** knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he **kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God,** as he did aforetime.

Even Jesus knelt down to pray to God the Father.

Luke 22:41

41 And he was withdrawn from them about a stone's cast, **and kneeled down, and prayed,**

God's Psychology on “Humbling” ourselves before Him:

James 4:6

6 **But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.**

Matt 23:12

12 **And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.**

X. YOU WILL SEE THAT WE FEED THE POOR WITH MONEY OF THE RICH:

God expects the “Body of Christ” to help feed and clothe the ‘Poor and the Needy’. He also expects the ‘richer’ churches to give money to help the ‘Poorer’ churches. By helping the ‘Poorer’ churches, they in turn can help feed and clothe the ‘Poor and needy’. Thus both get Blessed!

Deut 15:7-11

7 If there be among you a poor man of one of thy brethren within any of thy gates in thy land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not harden thine heart, nor shut thine hand from thy poor brother:

8 But thou shalt open thine hand wide unto him, and shalt surely lend him (pledge to him) sufficient for his need, in that which he wanteth.

If we do not help the ‘Poor’, and they cry out to the Lord against us, we have committed Sin.

9 Beware that there be not a thought in thy wicked heart, saying, The seventh year, the year of release, is at hand; and thine eye be evil against thy poor brother, and thou givest him nought; and he cry unto the LORD against thee, and it be sin unto thee.

We must give with the proper attitude in our heart. (2 Corinthians 9:7)

10 Thou shalt surely give him, and thine heart shall not be grieved when thou givest unto him: because that for this thing the LORD thy God shall bless thee in all thy works, and in all that thou putteth thine hand unto.

Giving is a commandment - not a suggestion!

11 For the poor shall never cease out of the land: therefore I command thee, saying, Thou shalt open thine hand wide unto thy brother, to thy poor, and to thy needy, in thy land.

Ps 82:3-4

3 Defend the poor and fatherless: do justice to the afflicted and needy.

4 Deliver the poor and needy: rid them out of the hand of the wicked.

Lending to the ‘Poor’:

We as the “Body of Christ”, are not to ‘Lend’ money to the ‘Poor’. We are not to collect interest (usury), nor to expect anything in return. If the ‘Poor’ receive ‘goods’ from us, do not expect them to be returned!

Exod 22:25

25 **If thou lend money to any of my people that is poor by thee, thou shalt not be to him as an usurer, neither shalt thou lay upon him usury.**

Luke 6:34

34 **And if ye lend to them of whom ye hope to receive, what thank have ye? for sinners also lend to sinners, to receive as much again.**

Luke 6:30

30 **Give to every man that asketh of thee; and of him that taketh away thy goods ask them not again.**

Those that do not help feed and defend the 'Poor and the Needy', particularly those in the churches, are called 'Wicked'!

Jer 5:26-28

26 **For among my people are found wicked men: they lay wait, as he that setteth snares; they set a trap, they catch men.**

27 **As a cage is full of birds, so are their houses full of deceit: therefore they are become great, and waxen rich.**

*Notice: Churches that have become great, become rich, and prosper, are not necessarily in God's Will!!

28 **They are waxen fat, they shine: yea, they overpass the deeds of the wicked: they judge (defend) not the cause, the cause of the fatherless, yet they prosper; and the right of the needy do they not judge (defend).** (Revelation 3: 17)

One of Sodom's Sins, was they did not help the 'Poor and Needy'.

Ezek 16:49-50

49 **Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy.**

50 **And they were haughty, and committed abomination before me: therefore I took them away as I saw good.**

God is going to provide for those that are helping the 'Poor and the 'Needy'!

Prov 19:17

17 **He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the LORD; and that which he hath given will he pay him again.**

Especially His Messengers!

Isa 45:1-3

1 **Thus saith the LORD to his anointed**, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have holden, to subdue nations before him; and I will loose the loins of kings, to open before him the two leaved gates; and the gates shall not be shut;

2 **I will go before thee**, and make the crooked places straight: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron:

3 **And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places**, that thou mayest know that I, the LORD, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel.

And to His churches!

Isa 60:11

11 **Therefore thy gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day nor night; that men may bring unto thee the forces (wealth) of the Gentiles**, and that their kings may be brought.

Rev 3:8

8 **I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it:** for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.

EXAMPLES OF GIVING:

A fifty per cent tithe!

Luke 19:2

2 And, behold, **there was a man named Zacchaeus, which was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich.**

Luke 19:8

8 **And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor;** and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold.

A church giving to the 'Poor Saints'.

Rom 15:26

26 **For it hath pleased them of Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor saints which are at Jerusalem.**

The Apostles/Messengers are reminded to remember the 'Poor'.

Gal 2:10

10 **Only they would that we should remember the poor;** the same which I also was forward to do.

This is the 'Fast' that God has chosen!

Isa 58:6-7

6 Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?

7 Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh (kin or family)?

THE RESULTS OF FEEDING THE POOR:**Isa 58:8-11**

8 Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy reward (rear guard).

9 Then shalt thou call, and the LORD shall answer; thou shalt cry, and he shall say, Here I am. If thou take away from the midst of thee the yoke, the putting forth of the finger, and speaking vanity;

10 And if thou draw out thy soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul; then shall thy light rise in obscurity, and thy darkness be as the noonday:

11 And the LORD shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought, and make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.

Praise The Lord !!

CONCLUSION:

I pray that all who are “Called” to give these “Ten Commandments to the Church”, will do so with all ‘**Boldness**’ through God the Holy Spirit!

As they do, God will do His part, by confirming the Word with ‘Miracles, Signs and Wonders’ following in the Name of Jesus!

‘**Boldness**’ in the Greek means:

3954 parrhesia (par-rhay-see'-ah);

All out-spokenness, i.e. frankness, bluntness, publicity; by implication, assurance: KJV-- **bold** (-ly, -ness, -ness of speech), confidence, freely, openly, plainly (-ness).

Acts 4:29-37

29 **And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word,**

30 **By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.**

31 **And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.**

I pray that the “Body of Christ” will soon become of one heart and one soul.

32 **And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.**

33 **And with great power (dunamis) gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.**

Acts 5:12

12 **And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch.**

I pray that those in the “Body of Christ” will distribute to the needs of others, so that we will ‘truly’ have all things in common. A 100% tithe!

34 **Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold,**

35 **And laid them down at the apostles' feet: and distribution was made unto every man according as he had need.**
