

10. THE SPIRIT OF FEAR: (This “spirit” is one of the worst because it deprives a person of their love and joy. The person’s health deteriorates and they cannot sleep. (Prov. 17:22) This can lead to depression and thoughts of suicide).

2 Tim 1:7 For **God hath not given us the spirit of fear;** but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

1 Jn 4:18 There is no fear in love; but **perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment.** He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

11. A SPIRIT OF INFIRMITY: (This “spirit” is the cause of many people’s sicknesses and infirmities. When they get delivered, they usually get healed).

Luke 13:11-13 And, behold, **there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity** eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself.

And when **Jesus** saw her, he called her to him, and **said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.**

And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

12. A BLIND SPIRIT: (Sometimes people have bad eyes or cloudy eyes when “Demon” possessed. This is usually caused by a “Blind spirit”).

Matt 12:22 Then was brought unto him **one possessed with a devil, blind,** and dumb: and he healed him, insomuch that **the blind** and dumb both spake and **saw.**

13. SPIRIT OF ANTI-CHRIST: (This “spirit” is difficult to deliver, because people do not believe they have it. They say they believe in Jesus, but they don’t).

1 Jn 4:3 **And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist,** whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

14. SPIRIT OF ERROR: (Gives people a desire for the things of this world).

1 Jn 4:5-6 **They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world,** and the world heareth them.

We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. **Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.**

CONCLUSION: (Read the Study Guide on “Demons” by Timothy II)

1 Cor 12:7-8, 10 (First, ask the Holy Spirit for the “discernment of spirits”)

But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

For to one is given by the Spirit...

To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; **to another discerning of spirits;...**

1 Jn 4:1 (Then Test the “spirits”)

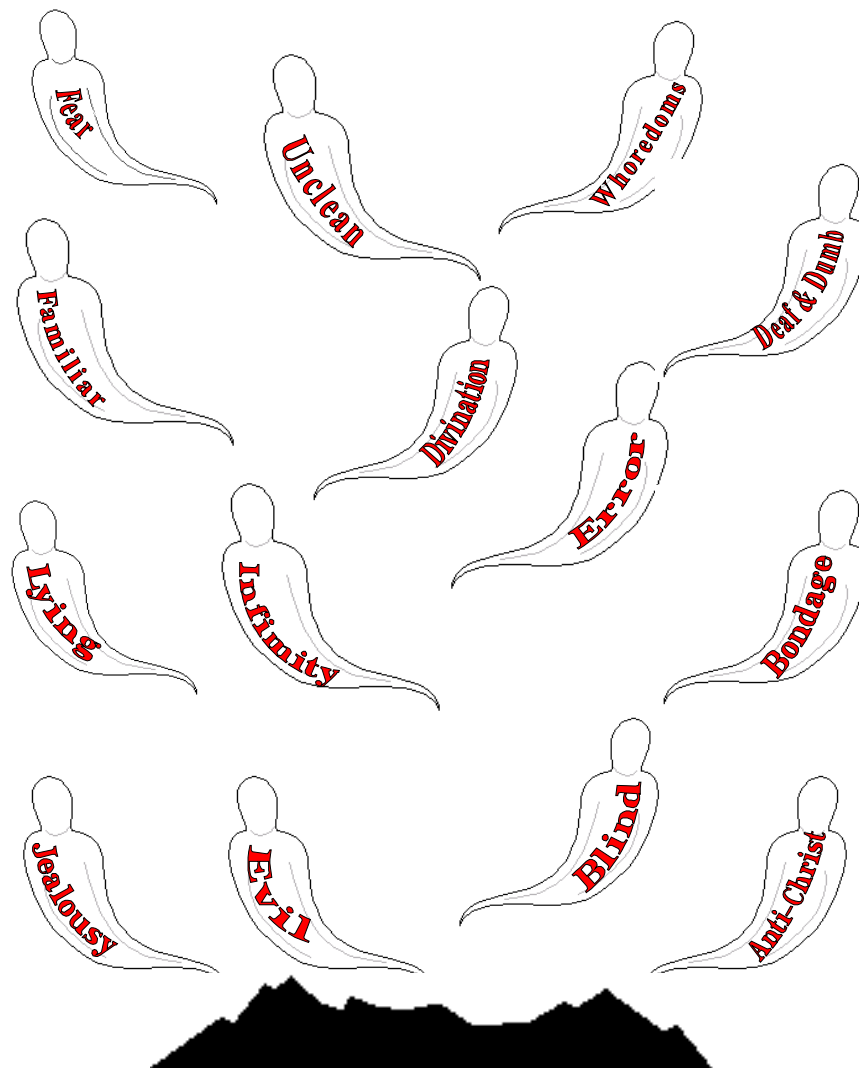
Beloved, believe not every spirit, but **try the spirits whether they are of God:** because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

FOUL SPIRITS



OF SATAN

INTRODUCTION: FOUL SPIRITS OF SATAN:

FOUL SPIRITS: (This is a general term for all “Demonic spirits”).

Rev 18:2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every **foul spirit**, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

The Bible teaches that there are 14 “Foul spirits of Satan”.

1. UNCLEAN SPIRITS: (There can be many in one person. They can cause all kinds of sexual perversion. They may be vocal and will try to harass you).

Matt 10:1 (Mark 6:7) (Jesus) ...**he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out,.....**

Mark 5:8-9 (Jesus) For **he said unto him, Come out of the man, thou unclean spirit.**

And he asked him, What is thy name? And he answered, saying, **My name is Legion: for we are many.**

Acts 8:7 For unclean spirits, crying with loud voice, came out of many that were possessed with them:

2. FAMILIAR SPIRITS: (Those with “Familiar spirits” are the ones that people sometimes go to, in order to get counsel or to know the future).

Lev 19:31 Regard not them that have familiar spirits, neither seek after wizards, to be defiled by them: I am the LORD your God.

Lev 20:6 And the soul that turneth after such as have familiar spirits, and after wizards, to go a whoring after them, I will even set my face against that soul, and will cut him off from among his people.

3. A SPIRIT OF DIVINATION: (This “spirit” is stronger than “Familiar spirits”. This ‘spirit’ works through flattery, lies and deceit). (1Thess. 2:5)

Acts 16:16 And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying:

Ezek 12:24 For there shall be no more any vain vision nor **flattering divination.....**

Ezek 13:7 Have ye not seen a vain vision, and have ye not spoken a **lying divination**, whereas ye say, The LORD saith it; albeit I have not spoken?

4. DEAF & DUMB SPIRITS: (These “spirits” should be the first ones you cast out. If you don’t they shut the ears of the person so they can’t hear you).

Mark 9:25-26 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the **foul spirit**, saying unto him, **Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.**

And the spirit cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him:

Mark 9:29 (You need to fast and pray to deliver Deaf & Dumb spirits)

And he (Jesus) said unto them, **This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.**

5. EVIL SPIRITS: (“Evil spirits” are not powerful; however, you better know Jesus as your Lord and savior before you try to ‘cast them out’).

Luke 7:21 And in that same hour he cured many of their infirmities and plagues, **and of evil spirits**; and unto many that were blind he gave sight.

Luke 8:2 And certain women, **which had been healed of evil spirits** and infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, out of whom went **seven devils**,

6. THE SPIRIT OF WHOREDOMS: (This “spirit” can cause two types of “Whoredoms”; ‘spiritual’ Whoredoms which leads to idolatry (Ex. 34:14-16 Eze. 14:3-5), and ‘physical’ Whoredoms which leads to fornication & adultery).

Hosea 4:12-13 My people ask counsel at their stocks, and their staff declareth unto them: **for the spirit of whoredoms hath caused them to err, and they have gone a whoring from under their God.**

They sacrifice upon the tops of the mountains, and burn incense upon the hills, under oaks and poplars and elms, because the shadow thereof is good: **therefore your daughters shall commit whoredom, and your spouses shall commit adultery.**

7. THE SPIRIT OF JEALOUSY: (This “spirit” is a major cause of divorce. It causes a lack of trust, and suspicion of everyone and everything. It can cause the person to become violent and have fits of rage and anger). (Prov. 29:22)

Num 5:14 (Num 5:30) And the spirit of jealousy come upon him, **and he be jealous of his wife**, and she be defiled: or if the spirit of jealousy come upon him, **and he be jealous of his wife**, and she be not defiled:

Prov 6:34 For jealousy is the rage of a man:

8. THE SPIRIT OF BONDAGE: (This is the “demon” that can cause people to become addicted to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, etc. However, most of the time this is the “works of the flesh”. (Gal. 5:19, 20) This “spirit” can also harass Christians into having a fear of falling back into their old lifestyle).

Rom 8:15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

Gal 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, **and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.**

9. A LYING SPIRIT: (This is the “spirit” that may be the cause of habitual lying, particularly in young people. When all else has failed, try doing a deliverance of this “spirit”.)

IKing 22:22-23 2 Chr 18:21-22 And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a **lying spirit** in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so.

Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a **lying spirit** in the mouth of all these thy prophets, and the LORD hath spoken evil concerning thee.

Prov 6:16-17 These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him:

A proud look, a **lying tongue**, and hands that shed innocent blood,

Prov 12:22 Lying lips are abomination to the LORD: but they that deal truly are his delight.
