Acts 2:32-33 (Peter mentioned The Three when speaking of Jesus' resurrection)

32 This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses.

33 Therefore being by the Right Hand of God exalted (being lifted up), and having received of The Father the promise of The Holy Ghost (Spirit)...

Acts 5:30-32 (Peter said he and The Holy Spirit were Witnesses of these things)

30 The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, who ye slew and hanged on a tree.

31 Him hath God exalted with His Right Hand to be a Prince and a Saviour...

32 And we are His witnesses of these things; and so is also The Holy Ghost (Spirit), whom God hath given to them that Obey Him (believe in Him).

Acts 7:55 (Stephen, full of The Spirit, actually saw Jesus at God's Right Hand)

55 But He, being full of The Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into Heaven, and saw The Glory of God, and Jesus standing on the Right Hand of God.

Acts 11:16-17 (God Baptizes with The Holy Spirit those who Believe in Jesus)

16 Then remembered I (Peter) the word of The Lord, how that He said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be Baptized with The Holy Ghost.

17 Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as He did unto us, who believed on The Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God?

Rom 14:17-18 (God accepts those who Serve Christ in the things of The Spirit)

17 For the Kingdom of God is not meat (eating) and drink (drinking); but righteousness, and peace, and joy in The Holy Ghost (Spirit).

18 For he that in these things serveth Christ is acceptable to God...

1 Thess 1:3, 5 (Remember our hope in Jesus in sight of God and The Holy Spirit)

3 Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of Love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of God and our Father;

5 For our Gospel (Good News) came not unto you in word only, but also in Power, and in The Holy Ghost (Spirit), and in much assurance (confidence);

FINALLY Now that you know The Godhead consists of The Father, The Son & The Holy Spirit, and these Three are One; Go and teach these things to all People!


Matt 28:19-20 (Baptizing them in The Name of The Father, Son and Holy Spirit)

19 Go ye therefore, and Teach (instruct, disciple) all Nations, Baptizing them in The Name of The Father, and of The Son, and of The Holy Ghost (Spirit);

20 Teaching them to observe (keep) all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and lo I am with you always, even unto the end of the world (age) Amen!

THE GODHEAD

The KJV of the Bible states that The Godhead consists of God The Father, God The Son, and God The Holy Ghost! It also states that The Godhead exists as Three in One!

1 John 5:7 (And there are Three that bear witness to these things in Heaven)
7 For there are Three that bear record in Heaven, The Father, The Word
(which is Jesus - Rev 19:13), **and The Holy Ghost: and these Three are One.**

Since we have ministered in many different Countries, we have found that most people that accept the Lord, do so when we teach them what is actually stated IN the Bible! This is because many come from other religions and they want to see what the Bible says as proof that what we are telling them is True. I also believe The Holy Spirit becomes a major influence upon them when we use the absolute Word of God! An example of this is when I met a Mormon Woman who was studying to become a Jehovah's Witness. When I started telling her about who God is, she said you know the word Trinity is not in the Bible! I agreed with her that the word Trinity does not appear in the Bible; but then I shared that God as Three in One, is actually called The Godhead IN the Bible! Then I showed her the Scriptures that prove it, and she soon accepted Jesus as her Lord and Savior!

1 John 5:8, 6 (And there are Three that bear witness to these things in Earth)
8 And there are Three that bear witness in earth, The (Holy) Spirit, and the water, and the blood (John 19:34): **and these Three agree in One.**
6 This is He that came by water and blood even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is The (Holy) Spirit that bears witness...

REFERENCES IN THE DICTIONARY AND IN THE GREEK

THE DICTIONARY STATES: The Godhead is the nature of God, especially as existing in Three Persons! **IN THE GREEK:** NT:2304 theios 2305 theiotes 2316 theos 2320 theotes means The Godhead, Divine, Divinity, God, and/or The Supreme Divinity. NT 40 hagios 4151 pneuma means Holy Ghost or Holy Spirit.

SCRIPTURES THAT REFER SPECIFICALLY TO THE GODHEAD

The following are the Scriptures that refer Specifically to The Godhead.

Acts 17:29 (And we that are Born of God should know who The Godhead is!).
29 Forasmuch then as we are the offspring (Born) of God, we ought not to think that The Godhead (2304) **is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven** (etched or sculptured) **by art and man's device** (man's thoughts or thinking).
Rom 1:20 (Because ALL things are clearly seen from the Creation of the World)
20 For the invisible things of Him from the Creation of the World are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His Eternal Power and Godhead (2305); **so that they are without excuse:**

Col 2:9-10 (In Jesus Christ dwells all the Fullness of The Godhead physically)
9 For in Him (Christ) **dwelleth** (is permanently housed) **all the Fulness of The Godhead** (2320) **bodily** (corporeally). **10 And ye are complete in Him...**

2 Peter 1:3-4 (God has given us All things by His Godhead Power and Nature)
3 According as His Divine (2304 Godhead) **Power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and Godliness, through the knowledge of Him that hath Called us to glory** (honor) **and virtue** (moral excellence):
4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of The Divine (2304 Godhead) **Nature...**

SCRIPTURES THAT REFER TO THE FATHER, SON & HOLY GHOST

These Scriptures refer to The Father, Son & Holy Ghost, which IS The Godhead!

Mark 12:35-36 (Here They are mentioned in reference to the Old Testament)
35 And Jesus answered and said, while He taught in the Temple, How say the scribes that Christ is the Son of David? (Luke 20:42-44 Psalms 110:1)
36 For David himself said by The Holy Ghost (Spirit), **The Lord** (God) **said to My Lord, Sit thou on My Right Hand till I make thy enemies thy footstool.**
Luke 1:35 (Here The Three are mentioned by an Angel that spoke to Mary)
35 And the angel answered and said unto her (Mary), **The Holy Ghost** (Spirit) **shall come upon thee, and the Power of The Highest shall overshadow thee** (in a brilliant haze with preternatural influence): **therefore also that** (Most) **Holy Thing which shall be Born of thee shall be called The Son of God.**

Luke 3:21-22 (The Three are mentioned here as Jesus was being Baptized)
21 Now when all the people were Baptized, it came to pass, that Jesus also being Baptized, and praying, the Heaven was opened,
22 And The Holy Ghost (Spirit) **descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon Him, and a Voice came from Heaven, which said, Thou art My beloved Son;..**
Acts 10:38 (God Anointed Jesus with The Holy Spirit, which is The Godhead)
38 How God (The Father) **Anointed Jesus of Nazareth with The Holy Ghost** (Spirit) **and with Power** (dunamis): **who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil** (Satan); **for God was with Him.**

John 14:25-26 (Here Jesus spoke of The Three in One to His Disciples)
25 These things have I (Jesus) **spoken unto you, being yet present with you.**
26 But the Comforter, which is The Holy Ghost (Spirit), **whom The Father will send in My Name, He shall teach you all things...**

Acts 2:38-39 (Here Peter mentioned The Three as he spoke to the Jews)
38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be Baptized every one of you in The Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of Sins, and ye shall receive the
