

We are Saved by Grace through Faith, it cannot be earned through works!

Eph 2:5

5 Even when we were dead in sins, (God) hath quickened us together (made us alive) **with Christ, (by Grace** (unmerited Divine influence) **ye are Saved;**)

Eph 2:8-9

8 For by Grace (unmerited Divine influence) **are ye Saved through Faith** (belief in Christ); **and that not of yourselves: it is the gift** (Sacrifice) **of God:**
9 Not of works (acts, deeds), **lest** (so that not) **any man** (person) **should boast.**

2 Tim 1:9

9 Who hath Saved us, and called us with an Holy calling, not according to our works (acts or deeds), **but according to his own purpose and Grace,**
which was given us in Christ Jesus Before the world began,

Titus 3:5-6

5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he Saved us, by the washing (immersion or baptism) **of regeneration** (Spiritual rebirth), **and renewing** (renovation or restoring) **of the Holy Ghost;**
6 Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour;

THOSE NOT SAVED:

Unbelievers will Not be Saved just because they have heard the Word of God!

Luke 8:11-12 (The Parable of the Sower)

11 Now the parable (moral of the story) **is this: The seed is the word of God.**

12 Those by the way side (the seed that fell by the side of the road) **are they that hear** (the Word of God); **then cometh the devil** (Satan), **and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be Saved.**

Luke 13:23-24

23 Then said one unto him, Lord, are there few (puny in number) **that be Saved? And he** (Jesus) **said unto them,**

24 Strive to enter in at the strait (narrow) **gate: for many** (a great number), **I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.**

John 3:18 **Mark 16:16**

18 ...he that believeth not (is unbelieving) **is condemned** (damned) **already,**
because he hath not believed in the Name of the Only begotten Son of God.

Heb 3:12 (Therefore)

12 Take heed (Beware), **Brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief, in** (by) **departing** (falling away or withdrawing) **from the living God.**

THE GOOD NEWS IS:

If you Turn & Repent & Believe in JESUS, you WILL BE SAVED! (Jer 31:19)

John 3:15-17

15 That whosoever Believeth in him should not perish, but have Eternal life.

16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that Whosoever Believeth in him should not perish, but have Everlasting life.

17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn (or punish) **the world; but that the world through him might be Saved.** (Acts 3:19)

THE GREATEST QUESTION?

The Greatest Question that anyone can ask while here on earth is: “WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED”? This is because no matter how you answer this question, the answer is Eternal!! In the Bible, this Question was asked by the Keeper of a prison where the Disciples Paul and Silas were imprisoned. When an earthquake struck, this Jailor thought the two had escaped from their cells. This would have caused him to be put to Death, so he was going to kill himself. However, Paul cried out ‘We are here, do not harm yourself’. This caused the Jailor to ask the Great Question: “WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED”?

SAVED & SALVATION!

What does it mean to be Saved? What is the meaning of Salvation?

The Dictionary States:

Saved means to be delivered from Sin!

Salvation is deliverance from the power and effects of Sin!

The Bible States:

Saved in Hebrew means to be free, be delivered, get victory, Salvation, Savior!

Salvation in Hebrew means something Saved, free, deliverance and victory!

Saved in Greek means to Save, to deliver, to be (or to make) whole!

Salvation in Greek means to rescue or deliver, a deliverer, i.e. God or Christ!

THE STORY:

Acts 16:23, 26-27, 29-31

23 And when they (a mob) had laid many stripes upon them (Paul & Silas), they cast them into prison, charging the Jailor to keep them safely:

26 And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened,...

27 And the Keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself,...

29 Then he called for a light, and sprang in (rushed in), and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas,

30 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, “What must I do to be Saved”?

31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be Saved, and thy House (Household or Family),

GOD’S ANSWER:

God’s answer to “The Greatest Question” is that He would have All people to be Saved; however, as people of choice it is entirely up to us!

1 Tim 2:4-6

4 (God our Saviour) Who will have all men (human beings) to be Saved, and to come unto the knowledge (full discernment) of the truth.

5 For there is One God, and One mediator (go-between, reconciler or intercessor) between God and men (human beings), the man Christ Jesus;

6 Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due (the proper) time.

Heb 5:9

9 And being made perfect (complete), he became the author (causative) of Eternal Salvation unto all them that obey (hearken or give heed to) him;

When Jesus’ Disciples heard that a rich man could hardly be Saved; they asked who then can be Saved, and Jesus answered: “with God all things are possible”!

Matt 19:25-26 Mark 10:26-27 Luke 18:26-27

25 When his disciples heard it (about a rich man), they were exceedingly amazed (astonished), saying, Who then can be Saved? (Matt 19:23-24)

26 But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.

John 10:9 (Jesus stated)

9 I am the door (entrance or opening): by me if ANY man (person) enter in, he shall be Saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture (to feed on),

You may ask, but what about those that have never heard about Jesus?

Titus 2:11-13 (The Answer)

11 For the grace of God that bringeth Salvation hath appeared to All men,

12 Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly (sound in mind), righteously, and Godly, in this present world;

13 Looking for (awaiting with confidence) that blessed hope (expectation), and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

CONFIRMATIONS ON HOW TO BE SAVED:

The following Scriptures confirm God’s plan of Salvation & How to be Saved!

Mark 16:16

16 He that believeth (has Faith and commits to Trust) and is baptized (washed or immersed into Christ) shall be Saved;... (Gal 3:27-28)

Acts 4:12

12 Neither is there Salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men (human beings) whereby we Must be Saved.

Rom 5:8-9

8 But God commendeth (exhibited) his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

9 Much more then, being now justified (rendered innocent) by his blood, we shall be Saved from wrath (punishment) through him.

Rom 8:24

24 For we are Saved by hope (Faith): but hope (Faith) that is seen is not hope (Faith): for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for?

Rom 10:9-10 (And)

9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe (commit to trust) in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou Shalt be Saved.

10 For with the heart man believeth (commits to trust) unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto Salvation.

Rom 10:13

13 For whosoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be Saved.

1 Cor 1:18

18 For the preaching of the Cross (the atonement of Christ) is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are Saved it is the Power of God.
