

**1 Cor 8:9, 8:11**

**9 But take heed** (beware) **lest by any means this liberty of yours become a stumblingblock** (apostasy, offense, occasion of sin) **to them that are weak.**

**11 And through thy knowledge shall the weak brother perish** (die, be lost or fully destroyed), **for whom Christ died?**

**PRE - CONCLUSION:**

As Christians you have been Called unto “The Perfect Law of Liberty”; therefore, **do not** use this Freedom for an **Occasion** to the Flesh. (Jas 1:13-15)

**Gal 5:13**

**13 For, brethren, ye have been called** (bid or called forth) **unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion** (a starting point or opportunity) **to the flesh,...**

**Gal 5:1**

**1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.**

Beware of **False Brethren** that try to influence you into committing **Willful** or **Presumptuous** Sins and bring you back into bondage! (Heb 10:26 2 Pet 2:19)

**Gal 2:4**

**4 And that because of false brethren** (a pretended associate or a ‘spurious brother’ - which means outwardly similar without having its genuine qualities) **unawares brought in, who came in privily** (stealthily) **to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage:**

**Ps 19:13**

**13 Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous** (repeated, arrogant, proud, insolent) **sins; let them not have dominion** (power) **over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent** (free) **from the great transgression.**

Finally, do not put yourselves back under the “Law”! (2 Pet 2:22 Pr 26:11)

**2 Peter 2:20**

**20 For if after they have escaped the pollutions** (contaminated morally, defiled or foulness) **of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled** (involved with) **therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning.**

**CONCLUSION:**

If you have fallen into a Sinful state, then **Repent!** **And Pray this Prayer!**

**Ps 51:9-12**

**10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.**

**11 Cast me not away** (Don’t throw me out) **from thy presence** (face); **and take not thy holy spirit from me.**

**12 Restore unto me the joy** (cheerfulness, gladness and the joyfulness) **of thy salvation; and uphold me** (sustain me) **with thy free spirit** (of Liberty).

Then let the Holy Spirit rule and reign forever in your Life! (Rom 6:22)

**2 Cor 3:17**

**17 Now the Lord is that** (Holy) **Spirit: and where the** (Holy) **Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty** (Complete Freedom). **AMEN!** **TIMOTHY II**



## INTRODUCTION TO THE PERFECT “LAW OF LIBERTY”:

As Christians we are no longer under the “Law of Moses”; but instead we are now under “The Perfect Law of Liberty”. (Luke 16:16 John 1:17 Acts 13:39) Since Jesus died on the Cross for all of our Sins, we have been given complete “Freedom” as His ‘Servants’. (1 Cor 15:3 Gal 1:4 1 Pet 2:24)

This means that we are: “Free from Sin - but we are not Free to Sin”!!

### 1 Peter 2:16

16 As free, and not using your liberty for a cloke (pretext or covering) of maliciousness (depravity, evil or wickedness), but as the servants of God.

In other words, we are “Free” to do as we please; but knowing that our old man has been Crucified with Jesus, we are no longer Servants to Sin. (Rom 6:3-23)

### Rom 6:1-2

1 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?

2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein?

The Good News is, even if we do commit “Sin”, we have an advocate (intercessor) with the Father who is Jesus Christ. So as Christians, if we do stumble or fall, all we have to do is to ask God the Father to forgive us through Jesus Christ His Son, and it is done! (1 John 2:1-2 1 John 1:9)

## THE MEANING OF THE “LAW AND LIBERTY” IN ENGLISH:

\*The Law implies imposition by a sovereign authority and the obligation of obedience on the part of all subject to that authority. \*A rule of conduct or action prescribed or formally recognized as binding or enforced by a controlling authority. \*The whole body of such customs, practices, or rules, and/or the control brought about by the existence or enforcement of such law. \*The action of laws considered as a means of redressing wrongs. \*The revelation of the will of God set forth in the Old Testament. \*The first part of the Jewish Scriptures (The Pentateuch, Torah). \*Liberty is the quality or state of being Free; also the power of choice. \*The power to do as one pleases or Freedom from physical restraint. \*Permission especially to go Freely within specified limits!

## THE MEANING OF “LAW AND LIBERTY” IN HEBREW & GREEK:

OT:8451 towrah (to-raw’); or torah (to-raw’); a precept or statute, especially the Decalogue or Pentateuch: KJV - Law.

OT:1865 derowr (der-ore’); freedom; hence, spontaneity of outflow, and so clear: KJV - Liberty, pure.

NT:3551 nomos (nom’-os); Law (through the idea of prescriptive usage), (regulation), specifically (of Moses [including the volume]; also of the Gospel), or figuratively (a principle): KJV - Law.

NT:1657 eleutheria (el-yoo-ther-ee’-ah); freedom (legitimate or licentious, chiefly moral or ceremonial): KJV - Liberty.

NT:859 aphasis (af-es-is); freedom; (figuratively) pardon: KJV - Liberty, deliverance, forgiveness, remission.

## THE LAW OF MOSES:

The difficulty in becoming Justified by the “Law of Moses”, is because if you offend in one point, you become guilty of all of the Law. (Acts 13:39)

## James 2:10-11

10 For whosoever shall keep the whole (all the, or complete) law, and yet offend (Sin, fall, stumble, trip, error, fail) in one point, he is guilty of all.

11 For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill (murder or slay). Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill (murder or slay), thou art become a transgressor (breaker or violator) of the law.

Although we have been Freed from the “Law of Moses” some Christian Leaders still want to put us back under the Law through the Laws and Traditions of men!

### 1 Tim 1:6-7

6 From which some having swerved (deviated from the truth) have turned

aside unto vain jangling (random talk or babble, senseless or mischievous);

7 Desiring (choosing, preferring, wishing, being inclined) to be teachers of the

law (expounders of the Jewish Law); understanding (comprehending, heeding,

considering, perceiving or thinking) neither what they say, nor whereof they

affirm (confirm thoroughly or constantly).

## UNDERSTANDING THE PERFECT “LAW OF LIBERTY”:

Those Christians that are Led by the Holy Spirit are NOT under the “Law of Moses” but are now under “The Perfect Law of Liberty”!

### Gal 5:18

18 But if ye be led (directed) of the (Holy) Spirit, ye are not under the law.

Those that comprehend “The Perfect Law of Liberty” do not deceive themselves, but become ‘doers’ of the Word of God and not hearers only.

### James 1:22, 25,

22 But be ye doers (a performer or one that takes an active part) of the word

(logos), and not hearers (merely a hearer or listener) only, deceiving

(beguiling, deluding, misreckoning) your own selves.

If you continue in God’s “Perfect Law of Liberty” you will not become a forgetful hearer; but will stay a ‘doer’ of the work of God and be Blessed!

25 But whoso looketh (peers within) into the perfect (complete, of full age)

law of liberty, and continueth (stays in, remains, is permanent, or abides)

therein, he being not a forgetful (negligent) hearer, but a doer (a performer

or one that takes an active part) of the work (as an effort or occupation), this

man shall be blessed (supremely blessed, well off, happy) in his deed (actions

or performance of the Law).

Even though we as Christians are now under “The perfect “Law of Liberty””, God’s judgment still prevails! Therefore, do not do the things that you speak out against, or you yourself shall be judged by “The Law of Liberty”!

### Jas 2:12-13

12 So speak ye (talk, utter words, preach), and so do (abide, perform), as they

that shall be judged (condemned, punished, determined, called in question,

and/or sentenced) by the law of liberty.

13 For he shall receive judgment (Divine Law) without mercy, that hath

shewed no mercy; and mercy rejoiceth against (exults over) judgment.

Do not allow your “Liberty” to become a stumbling-block to the weak.
